School Absences

Consistent school attendance is very important for the optimal educational growth of your child. If your child must be absent from school, please inform the office: svoffice@ksdr1.net. It is most beneficial that if your child misses school he/she gets the work that he/she misses each day. You may pick up your child's work at the end of the day by letting the office know when you call in the absence so we can have the work ready. If you know your child is going to be absent from school in advance, please let your homeroom teacher know.

Communication



We strongly encourage an open door policy when it comes to staying informed about your child. The school office email svoffice@ksdr1.net and the office phone number is 816-628-4652. Email is probably the quickest and easiest way to get in touch with us. Feel free to call us before or after school or during our planning time (10:25-11:15) to discuss any aspect of your child's educational experience. Your input is always appreciated.



Students need to bring a water bottle to school and should <u>only have water in their bottles</u>. It must have a lid and <u>preferably a "pop-top" to avoid spills</u>. We have bottle filling stations at school for students to use. Students may bring in a personal healthy snack daily. <u>Snacks must be packaged and include an ingredient label</u>.



4th Grade Binder

Each child will have a binder that will include folders and fourth grade information. Please review any paperwork in the front and back pockets that needs to be completed, read, or returned.



Our specials will be on a rotation and will be 10:25-11:15 a.m. daily. Students will rotate between library, art, music, and P.E. (LAMP). Please help your child have the materials they need for the daily special-tennis shoes, etc. Our lunchtime is 12:50-1:10. A parent/guardian must alert the office when any visitor is coming to be with your child such as for lunch.

It is our goal for students to spend about <u>40 minutes or less</u> a night on homework. <u>Included in this time should be nightly reading</u>. Students are encouraged to work on the Math ALEKS program if they have computer access at home. Typically the only other homework students will have will be a nightly math page that was not completed in class, and a reading passage given on Monday and due on Friday. Students who do not use their class time effectively will have more homework.

<u>Discipline</u>
