

To Do Items

PREPARE ALL BEDS*
WEED IN BACK OF GREENHOUSE
CAREFULLY WEED FLOWER BED
WEED AROUND THE GARDEN OUTSIDE THE BEDS NEAR WHITE FENCE
WEED LETTUCE BED
Coldframe
plant parsley and dill in cold frame
weed out old plants and plant small peppers and eggplant in cold frame.
Herb Garden continue to weed (only do this if you know what the perennials are)
Plant Basil seeds in a pot outside
Flower Gardens
Plant sunflowers near the privacy fence around the garden.
Plant calundula and sunflowers in the flower garden
Plant zinnia seeds in flower bed
Outdoor Garden
Plant Beans in bed 4
Plant squash in pots or outside in bed 1
Add compost to raspberries behind greenhouse when the compost is ready
Add wire to the back of the raspberries behind the greenhouse
Tie raspberries to the wire (picture on bulletin board)
Transplant young raspberries (in flower bed) to the bed in back of the greenhouse
Compost

Housekeeping
Clean tools to kill bacteria and pests
clean pots and stack neatly in back of greenhouse for next year
Organize and clean greenhouse

***Remove chickweed & and other weeds. Remove milk weed that is in front of the flowers. Leave some in the back of the garden for the Monarch butterflies. This is the only food that they eat. Be mindful that some flowers reseed. We have some perennial blue coneflowers; calendula; reseeded marigolds; reseeded violas; please pull out only weeds that you know are weeds.**

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
