Instead, the Instagram feed will be on the local NA events page - https://na.org/local-recovery-events/. The first meeting we held on August 17, 2025 and nine members attended. We will

continue to meet every third Sunday of the month, unless otherwise indicated. The next meeting scheduled to be held on Sunday, September 21, 2025 will be a continuation on the topic of, "Disruptive and Predatory Behavior in NA." Highlights/notes from the meeting (special thank you to Carly M. for preparing the document):

Topic for Review: Disruptive & Predatory Behavior

What characterizes an atmosphere of recovery?

Asking someone if it is ok to hug instead of just hugging, healthy communication, ability to use your voice as a newcomer, resolving conflict through discussion, mindful of language, not putting people in service positions/tasks they aren't qualified for.

A discussion about the greeter position took place. Pros and Cons of the position were discussed.

Pros - it can make some feel welcome from the moment they arrive

Cons - some people do not like to be touched and feel unsafe hugging someone of the opposite gender

Negative behavior - a conversation about the many different negative behaviors took place. A more lengthy discussion took place regarding unwanted sexual advances and how to handle them. Questions the group looked at regarding this topic:

Where does the majority of this take place?

What is the best way to address this?

How can this be discussed in person?

How does group autonomy come into play here?

A suggestion was made that perhaps each group could create a set of rules for behaviors that are not tolerated in their meeting space. A further discussion was had regarding this and how there could be negatives to this as well. It seems crucial that a new reading to be added to the format is beneficial. This way the language is NA approved and the message is heard each meeting.

What builds up the safety of the group? Allowing for group autonomy regarding a safety statement or set of rules for group behavior or a welcome letter. Homegroups having a plan for how behavior is addressed when it takes place in their meeting.

Addressing the overall behavior - how do we address these issues when they happen during open sharing? Depending on the behavior it could be addressed immediately "we don't do that here" ie someone yelling clean when someone says sober. Other behaviors may require 1 on 1 communication to prevent shaming ie vaping, excessive use of vulgar language, racism even if the person is being subtle about it.

How can this new topic be shared?

A new reading, a new IP, possibly a video, learning day
