

Medical Emergency Response Alert—Classroom Guidelines

- A “Medical Emergency” announcement means someone with a serious health problem or injury needs help.
- Trained staff will go to the location of the emergency immediately.
- It is important that the halls remain clear so staff and emergency personnel can easily get to the person in need.
- Once the announcement is made, students should go to or stay in a classroom even if a bell rings or it’s time to change class.
- Your teacher may need to help supervise a neighboring classroom or help at the scene. Students should sit quietly if a teacher is not present in the classroom.
- An “all clear” announcement will be made when the Medical Emergency is over and students may resume normal activities and leave their classrooms.
- If it’s the end of the day, the buses will wait for students to be dismissed.
