Student Expectations

- 1. Students are expected to remain on task and focused throughout the working portion of the class and give **full effort daily.**
- 2. Students are expected to be responsible for their own work, I will not continually ask a student 10 times for work. I will try to give time to work on homework every class period that there is homework.
- 3. Students are expected to be respectful to all students, and staff.
- 4. If a student is absent it is their responsibility to come talk to me about what they missed from the day or days they were absent.
- 5. **Phone policy-** Phones are not allowed during instructional time unless I ask a student to use it or a student gets permission from me to use their phone.
- 6. Cheating and/or plagiarism on an assignment will result in an automatic zero for the grade.
- 7. **Class Discussions -** Students making inappropriate comments will automatically be written up. I will be personally notifying the parents/guardians, coaches/activity sponsors, and the principal of the offensive action.
- 8. Late Assignments Any assignment that is turned in up to 7 days will be reduced by 20%. After that 1 week it will be a 50% reduction. If you are absent the day the assignment is due you will have until the next day you are in school to turn the assignment in. It is your responsibility to turn it in if it is late, I will not ask you to turn in late assignments. ***All late assignments will be due the Sunday night before the end of the Trimester. After this deadline late work will not be accepted.

Discipline Procedure:

- 1. 2 verbal warnings for minor infractions
- 2. After class or school discussion with student, parent, coach, or all 3.
- 3. Removed from class and sent to office for further discipline. (*Please note: If the offense is especially grievous such as a racist, sexist or homophobic verbal attack and/or a harmful act that is physical in nature, you will be excused automatically*)
