Virtual VA Outreach Program (FCCPS Teachers)

VIrtual Virginia Outreach program provides access to content, resources and an online learning environment. All VA Public School divisions have the autonomy to use and edit the content, import digital learning resources in a learning management system. The resources are aligned to the SOL standards. Each module is broken down into four components: introduction and objectives, content with a video attachment, application (games or interactive activity) and a hands on assignment. FCCPS teachers will oversee the teaching while also grading the assignments. Teachers will be able to transfer grades from online to face to face instruction. Since teachers have the autonomy to add and edit content, the pacing can also be closely aligned to FCCPS scope and sequence documents. Teachers can create additional modules to add any missing content (IB, current events) increase rigor and provide differentiated instruction.

Academic performance and usage analytics can be reviewed to see the students performance in Virtual VA outreach. This data collected can also be used to help with intervention support. This program integrates with Power School and uses the learning management system, Canvas.
