Early automobiles

Many inventors were trying(build) gas-powered, self-propelled vehicles in the late
1800's. A French inventor succeeded in(create) a steam-powered tricycle in 1769. A
German engineer, Nikolaus August Otto, is known for(invent) the four-stroke
gas-powered engine in 1876. Both Gottlieb Daimler and Carl Benz managed(build)
and(sell) autos in Germany in the 1880s. By 1898 there were 50 companies
responsible for _(market) cars in the United States alone. That number happened
_(expand) 241 by 1908. It was in 1908 when Henry Ford started(make) automotive
history. It was in that year that he managed(put) together the first assembly line and
_(lower) the price of automobiles so that everyone could buy one. He began
_(arrange) workers so that they could each do a small part of the job in sequence. This
prevented _from_(repeat) a log of unnecessary steps in the assembly process. By 1913
he managed _(produce) 250,000 cars a year. His first mass-produced car, the Model T,
guaranteed(give) modest-income Americans decent transportation for a reasonable
(\$500 USD!) price. Henry Ford went on(lead) the U.S. automobile industry for many
years. Though he tried, he failed _(get) elected to the U.S. Senate in 1918. His company
was started with just \$28,000 and, by 1913, managed(pay) dividends of \$11 million.
While Ford declined(give) away more than a modest amount during his lifetime, the
Ford Foundation arranges (donate) millions of dollars each year to deserving causes.
