



The Price is Right

For two to four players, you need: Two dice; deck of playing cards with numbers 1-10 (Ace=1, face cards removed)

This game focuses on close-by division facts. Deal six cards to each player. Player 1 rolls both dice and decides on a price (ex: a 5 and a 2 can become 25\$ or 52\$). Each player uses the cards in their hand to form a multiplication fact that comes as close to that price as possible without going over. The player with the closest product scores 12 points. If there is a tie, players evenly share the 12 points (ex: a three-way tie gives each player 4 points). Each player draws new cards to replace the ones they used. Repeat the process with Player 2, and so on, until the deck is gone. High score wins!
