Attention Deficits	• reduced task assignment • copies of instructional examples • video directions/tutorials • written directions
Autism Spectrum	• reduce unnecessary stimulation • breaking large amounts of information or instructions into smaller segment
Blindness	• audio recorded, brailled, or electronic-formatted notes, handouts, and texts • verbal descriptions of visual content by peer, teacher or aide • braille equipment labels
Deaf or Hard of Hearing	• (no sound features available with Cubelets)
Speech or Language Impairment	• audio/video directions/tutorials • visual, oral, and tactile demonstrations incorporated into instruction • alternative evaluation methods (e.g., portfolio, oral or video presentations)
Learning Disabilities	• note taking • audio/video directions/tutorials • visual, oral, and tactile demonstrations incorporated into instruction • concise course, lecture, and presentation outlines • breaking large amounts of information or instructions into smaller segment
Low Vision	• large-print reading materials • assignments in electronic formats • recorded presentations • verbal descriptions of visual aides
Orthopedic Impairments	• all equipment is located safely within reach and on an appropriate surface • device/program compatibility with student-provided devices • work with a partner to give building/assembly instructions
