

Call For Papers

BSides St. John's 2016 is happening on Thursday, September 15th, and will consist of a single speaking track. Regular presentation slot lengths are a fixed duration of 45 minutes plus 15 minutes for Q&A if necessary, while Lightning Talk presentation slot lengths are limited to 10-15 minutes in duration.

We will be live streaming the event and recording all presentations for later distribution. If the recording and live streaming of your presentation poses an issue for you then please contact us to discuss your concerns.

It is important to note that any presentations or talks deemed to be of a marketing or sales pitch nature will be politely rejected.

Submissions must be in plain text and specify:

- your preferred email address;
- if you are representing anyone (yourself, company name, group name);
- the title and detailed abstract for your presentation; and
- the approximate length of your presentation.

Additionally, your submission must answer the following questions.

- 1. Has this material been presented elsewhere? If so, where and when?
- 2. May we record and stream your presentation? If not, why?
- 3. Will you be traveling to the event? If so, from where? 1

Submissions must be emailed to BSidesStJohns@gmail.com. The CFP opens on April 14th and the deadline for submissions is August 18th. A confirmation of receipt of your submission will be sent within 48 hours. A follow-up email, if required, will be sent to you requesting further information or clarification.
