



# SPRINGO 2026 RULES SHEET

If this is your first time playing in a Bingo, welcome! You're gonna have a blast!

We figure most of you are either at work or actively playing RuneScape, but we ask that you read through each of the sections below **thoroughly** to ensure that everyone at least has some idea of what we expect from Springo. **If you have any questions, please ask a Moderator, Event Planner, Data Team Member, your team captain, or co-captain!**

Ready? Let's get right into it!

## Bingo Basics

*OSRS bingo works a bit differently than a bingo game you'd find at an old folks' home.*

- This year's Springo event will run from **March 14, 2026 to March 21, 2026** Each tile is worth points balanced to their difficulty.
- Tiles consist of various activities throughout OSRS, including skilling, PVM, speedrunning, minigames, and clue scrolls, just to name a few.
- Every tile you complete will be submitted on Discord in your team's individual drop submissions channel/thread. Once verified by an organizer/team captain, your team will be awarded the points for that tile.
- Earn the most points\* by the end of the event to win a share of the massive reward pot! The 1st place team receives 60% of the total buy-ins and donations, the 2nd place team receives 30%, and the 3rd place team receives 10%. In past events, this pot has exceeded TWO BILLION gp!  
\*See section below on how ties are handled
- *Do not change your RSN (in-game username) during the event.* There are things that are being tracked on the backend that will be screwed up. If you change your RSN it will result in your team **not getting credit for some stuff you do during bingo**

Now that you've got the Bingo TLDR, let's get into the nitty-gritty. Shall we?



## General Rules and Regulations

### Splitting:

- All drops received in group settings (raids, GWD, Nightmare, etc.) will be **SPLIT** between teammates present for the drop **unless otherwise specified by teammates ahead of time. It's best practice to put this in writing somewhere.**
- If you are FFA (free for all), you **MUST** state that ahead of time. If you do not tell your team you are FFA and do not split a drop, that is considered scamming and will be dealt with accordingly.

### Team Names:

- Each team will have a single opportunity to submit a list of three team names after the teams have been announced. These team names may not be:
  - Slurs or discriminatory in any manner
  - Related in any way to illegal sexual behavior (ex. rape, molestation, things no one wants in their games)
- The team name **MUST** be related in some way to Old School Runescape.
- Team names will be considered by Bingo Admins and confirmed to be acceptable.
  - In the case none of the submitted names are accepted, your team name will be chosen by the Bingo Admins from the list of “**List of boat descriptors and nouns**” name.

## Prohibited Behavior

### Griefing

- Griefing, ragging, PKing, crashing, or anything done to intentionally halt, hinder, or interrupt yours or another team's progress in bingo will result in immediate disqualification from the event.

### Stacking:

- Stacking is **discouraged**, it is not something easily tracked or validated so there is not a whole lot we can do here. We ask that you avoid stacking.
- Pre-loading any reward is not allowed. Examples include:
  - Raid's chests, Gauntlet chest, Barrows chest, Inferno runs at Zuk, etc. This is not an exhaustive list, all pre-loading is not allowed. If you have questions, please ask.
- For Springo 2026, the password is “Succulent”. Use this to complete the sign up form



### **Sandbagging:**

- Sandbagging (intentionally signing up with lower equipment, stats, or predicted time played) is not allowed in this event.
- If you gain an item that you would have had to list in the sign-ups, please ask an Event Planner to adjust the sign-up.
- Stat gain in between sign-ups and the draft is effectively inevitable, but stats at sign-up should align with Wise Old Man tracking.
- Predicted time played can be hard to properly predict, and we recognize this. HOWEVER, if your EHP (Efficient Hours Played) and EHB (Efficient Hours Bossed) exceeds 2 times the predicted amount, the following consequences will apply:
  - If you are caught sandbagging two bingos in a row you will be blocked from joining us for bingos for at least 1 bingo. If the problem persists, it may be for more than one event or permanent.
  - If you are a captain who we can show has consistently drafted a sandbagger or encouraged sandbagging, we will be less likely to allow you to captain in the future.

The rules stated so far are the most important in terms of things that you can get in trouble for breaking. If you have read all of the rules, you should know the password and should be good to complete your sign up form.

### **Misc:**

- All players are to log out 5 minutes before the start of the event to ensure boss and skilling high scores are accurately updated. (You may log back in once the event starts)
- Once the event has begun, players may **not** join teams unless permitted by the admin team. New players will only be added in cases where a team is missing players due to inactivity or drop-outs
- The Loot Tracker **is not** an acceptable replacement for the code word and drop notification in the chat box. Tiles submitted that are missing one or both of the aforementioned requirements but have a RuneLite loot tracker **will not count**.
- Screenshots for tiles must be taken in the **general vicinity** of where they are obtained/completed.



## Drop Submissions

*Drop submission screenshots are arguably the most important piece of any bingo event.*

- At the start of the event, we will announce a special bingo **CODEWORD** that must be visible in your screenshot for the drop to count.
  - you can either type it out in chat, message to a friend, or keep it on your screen via the “clan events” plug-in by Maz on RuneLite.
- **Simply having the drop in your inventory is not enough.** You must also have the drop notification in the chat box visible in the screenshot.
- Every time you receive a drop, achieve a milestone, show us your collection log, or complete a task that is on the board, you must submit a screenshot to Discord **WITH THE CODEWORD ON SCREEN, THE DROP NOTIFICATION IN THE CHAT BOX AND YOUR RSN VISIBLE.**
- Any and all submissions made **without** the aforementioned requirements will **NOT COUNT.**
  - Coordinate with your captain on where they would like for you to post your drops (for example, it could be in a Thread in your team’s chat channel)
- Group content can be sent with anyone, regardless of their team placement or if they’re playing bingo. Just remember, the drop **must be in your name or your teammate’s name** for it to count toward your score.

Note: You can also post any of your drops in the **#springo-2026-awesome-drops** channel to flex your loot to everyone. Keep in mind, **we don’t plan on using this channel to verify points.** If you have any questions, feel free to reach out to a bingo admin or any of your wonderful team captains for help.



## Tie Breakers Rules

Victory in Springo will be determined by the following metrics. Priority goes to the highest item on the list:

1. First to a Full Blackout (in the case of Springo 2026, completion of both the initial and the prestige board)
2. Number of Points
3. Number of Tiles Completed
4. Number of Tiles Prestiged

If there is a tie in every single category, the two teams that won will split the combined pot for the placements in which there is a tie. For example, if the leading teams, Team A and Team B, both have 50 tiles completed, both score exactly 300 points thanks to the partial point system, and both prestige 26 tiles, they would tie for first. Team C would come in 3rd, and the total split percentage would be 45/45/10

Tie Breaker split percentages are as follows:

- 1st place tie: 45/45/10
- 2nd place tie: 60/20/20
- 3rd place tie: 60/30/5/5

### **Pets:**

- If you receive a pet, unless otherwise stated, it can count for any object on its same collection log.
- Skilling Pets do not affect bingo.
- For tiles that have an assigned value or need for pets, you must use pets for their value or to complete the requirement for a pet before using it as a wild card.
