### General requirements

- In good academic standing in a Colorado/Denver Metro accredited school of nursing
- Intent to practice in the Colorado/Denver Metro area for at least two years following graduation.

### Application Selection criteria

- Candidate(s) submit a complete application packet by the application deadline (see checklist below)
- Application is received by the scholarship due date.

### Candidate Eligibility requirement

- Can show original proof of acceptance to an accredited school of nursing



## **Application submission requirements/checklist**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Two formal typed, signed, one-page recommendations. One from a current employer, past teacher, or counselor, and (optional) one from a current PNACO member who is not a relative that includes:
  - Statement of how well, how long, and in what capacity the recommender knows the applicant
  - Succinct statement as to why the applicant is worthy of scholarship funds in view of the chapter mission and the applicant's potential to contribute to the nursing profession
  - The applicant's goals and objectives, and potential for success in nursing
- \_\_\_\_\_ Proof of acceptance to an accredited educational program or current enrollment
- \_\_\_\_\_ One-page typewritten essay (see guidelines below)
