

Sugarbush Draft

The body should be wide and deep. The back should not be too long and should be strong with muscular loins and rounded hips. The shoulders should be sloping, deep, and muscular. Ideally, hip and wither height should be equal, without too much of a slope toward the center of the back.

The head characteristic of the breed should be bold and not too small with a profile that is flat or slightly convex. The neck should be of moderate length, with a well-defined throatlatch and break into the chest, muscular yet not too thick, arched, and well laid into the shoulder. The head should set into the neck at the right angle. A good head, neck, and shoulders denote character, giving the animal a good outlook.

Any base color is acceptable, with LP (leopard complex) pattern or characteristics being preferred, but not required if the horse meets all the other bloodline or confirmation requirements. Solids are acceptable. Pinto-type or excessive white markings; Tobiano, Frame Overo, Splash as well as Dominant White are prohibited.
