Youth in Action – Key action 1 –youth exchange

About the Project:

This youth exchange brings together three organizations from three different countries, with the purpose of sharing and learning more about the traditions and cultures of the participating countries. The participants will be stimulated to preserve and promote local traditions.

The aim of the project is that the young participants in the exchange become motivated and aware that they have the civic responsibility to preserve and promote local traditions, to develop a continuous dialogue between generations, between nations, and at the same time ensure the inclusion of young people with fewer opportunities.

Therefore, thanks to this youth exchange, we would like to:

- Involve the participants as active citizens in their relationship with the community, with their local traditions and habits;
- Develop their skills of preserving and capitalizing traditions in their communities;
- Raise awareness in order to promote the cultural diversity as an European value;
- Foster personal growth and development of key competencies among participants, especially those with fewer opportunities, through positive interaction with differences and active participation.

Accommodation:

Accommodation will be in the school, using classrooms as bedrooms. Showers are in a different building (sport pavilion style).

Costs:

Travel costs: will be reimbursed according the received grants from the Erasmus + program, based on the results of the distance calculator supported by the European Commission (http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance_en.htm)

We will reimburse that cost to the sending organization when we receive all the original documents we need (invoice, tickets, boarding passes, etc.).

Please note that it is not possible to reimburse without the original tickets and/or boarding passes. In addition one invoice or document that shows the name of the participants, date, route and price.

Original invoices and tickets must be delivered during the activity, except for those needed for the return trip, which should be sent by certified mail within 10 days after the end of the activity.

Every participant needs to take care of his/her own health and travel insurance for the period of the youth exchange and travel days. This cost can be included in the travel reimbursement (if the limit is not exceeded). Extra costs will not be refundable.

Duration:

19th to 26th of August 2023 (including travel days) – date to be confirmed

Location:

Íllora, Spain

Target Group:

Young people 15-16 (during the dates of the youth exchange); 8 participants + 2 leaders (+18, no age limit) per country.

We need gender balance.

Participants should speak English (to be able to communicate) and agree with the social contract (active participations, no alcohol, follow the rules, etc.).

Each national group will have some responsibilities: national evening, some games, workshops...

Commitments:

Partner organizations will select their participants in collaboration with the coordinating organization following the established criteria.

Partner organizations commit themselves to follow up throughout the project, providing the coordinating organization with everything necessary for the proper development of the project

They also commit themselves to giving visibility to the project by all means at their disposal (websites, social networks, etc.) and to carry out dissemination activities in collaboration with their participants.

In turn, the participants commit not only to active participation during the activity, but also to:

- To be in contact with the organizations before the activity and to carry out the tasks that are indicated to them.
- To carry out results dissemination activities in coordination with their sending organizations.
