This will be a juried competition. The theme of the challenge is: A Day in Our Community. Depict our community: The nature, people, and spaces, by showing moments of work, rest, play, connection, and joy. All art should reflect the theme and can feature any interpretation by the artist. All entries should be submitted with a brief artist's statement about the artist and work. (Art Explanation Card)

Art Challenge winners will be chosen based on grade/age, **how well the art is connected to the theme**, and quality of the art. Artist submissions will be shown and judged at the **Malheur Maker Faire**, **April 5**, **2025**.

Preliminary submission notice should be provided by **Friday**, **February 7th**, by the schools or artist. (For the <u>submission notice form</u>, <u>click here</u>. Form is also available on the **frontierstem.com** website.) Art will then be delivered to show and be judged at the Malheur Maker Faire no later than **Friday**, **March 7th**.

Selected art will be publicly displayed at the Four Rivers Cultural Center through April 18th. (Date subject to change).

Submission Details/Requirements:

- Art must be capable of hanging on a wall
- All art will be submitted with an Art Explanation Card
- Size requirements: No larger than 12" X 16"
- If needed, 12"X16" matboards will be provided to display art
- All art must be labeled with the artist's first and last name and school on the back of the artwork
