### **Chromebook Issues**

### Touchpad or screen not working

- Power it down with the power button on the side and turn it back on.
- Turn in Chromebook to your campus library

### Keys missing/battery won't stay charged

Turn in Chromebook to your campus library

### Slow/Sluggish

- Restart with power button
- Close all tabs except necessary ones
- Check the extensions and delete anything you don't recognize or that isn't being pushed out by the school
- Turn in Chromebook to your campus library

Restart your Chromebook on a regular basis. This is how it receives updates.

### Wifi Issues at Home

We do not troubleshoot wifi connection at home, but here are things you can try:

- 1. Make sure there aren't too many devices connected and streaming (ex take phones off)
- 2. Do an internet speed test (ex speedtest.net)
- 3. Check the wifi signal on the Chromebook
- 4. Call your internet service provider for more troubleshooting

# **Password Issues/Accounts**

If you can not remember your login or password, or you are unable to login, go to your campus library and ask for help.

# **Google Classroom**

### Log in

 You must be logged into your AISD account to access Google Classroom

Cannot edit a Classroom assignment that has already been turned in

 Once an assignment is turned in, the student loses editing access. You can unsubmit your assignment to regain editing rights.
