LESSON TITLE: Firebird	LESSON GOAL : The students will learn that Misty Copeland made history as the first African American Female Principal Dancer with the American Ballet Theatre.
INTRODUCE THE BOOK/STORY: (Read the story or use the video link.)	Have any of you ever seen ballet? We are going to find out about a famous ballerina named Misty Copeland. VIDEO BOOK LINK: Firebird by Misty Copeland
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: (Check for Understanding)	 What does Misty Copeland accomplish? What does she tell the young ballerina at the beginning of the story? Do any of you dance? Have you ever danced in a performance in front of others?
SUPPLIES NEEDED: None	ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION: We're going to watch a video to learn the 5 positions in ballet.
ACTIVITY (Students should do their own work):	Feet Positions for Ballet & Kids Bop Dance Video
CLOSING:	Watch this short video: Changing the Face of Ballet
GROUP GAME: Developmental Goal: To develop cooperation & teamwork. Equipment Needed: 1 ball per team	 Read through the game instructions ahead of time so that you can teach the activity. Use an attention-getter to gather students and make sure they are listening. Explain the game, the rules, and how to play the game. Check for understanding, have a few kids and staff demonstrate play. Link to game: Over Under
