Assessment
<u>iReady Diagnostic - K-5</u> (Achievement assessment administered to students in grades K-5 in Reading and Math. K-2 will have an additional final assessment in the Spring.)
<u>Predictive Assessment - K-5 - GPES & LVES</u> (Administered to students in selected students in K-5 schools)
<u>Predictive Assessment - Middle Schools</u> (Administered to students in grades 6-8 in middle schools)
<u>Predictive Assessment - High Schools</u> (Administered to students in grades 9-12 and all students who are currently enrolled in state EOC courses.)
<u>MAP</u> (Administered to students participating in Read 180 or Math 180 to measure academic growth and achievement)
<u>KRA: 5K Readiness</u> (Literacy assessment for 5K)
<u>Iowa and CogAT</u> (Grade 2-Achievement and Aptitude assessment, used for GT identification and Performance Task Assessment participation)
<u>PreACT or PSAT / NMSQT</u> (Grade 8 & 10 students will be tested, grade 7, 9, & 11 students can also pay to take the test)
<u>ASVAB</u> (Grade 11 students who are not taking PSAT and grade 12 students who have not yet met criteria for College and Career Readiness)
<u>WIN Career Readiness Assessment</u> (Math, Reading, and Data Employability Assessments including an Essential Soft Skills Test. Fall will be offered to Select 12th. Spring will be offered to all 11th and select 12th)
<u>myIGDIs & GOLD</u> (Measure for Literacy & Numeracy for 4K)
<u>ACCESS</u> (English proficiency assessment administered to designated MultiLingual students in grades K-12)

Performance Task Assessment

(Administered to students in grades 2-3 who have an aptitude score on file, and have met GT criteria with an aptitude or achievement score, and students in grades 4-5 who have met GT criteria with an aptitude or achievement score.)

Climate Surveys

(Parents, Teachers, Students 3rd-12th)

College Readiness Assessment

(ACT/SAT offered to grade 11/third year HS)

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams

SC Alternate

(Achievement test for grades 3-8, 11 special students requiring alt assessment)

SC Ready

(Summative achievement assessment grades 3-8 in ELA-Reading, ELA-Writing, and Math. Grade 4 and 6 will take Science)

EOCEP

(Administered to any Middle or High School students completing Algebra I/Intermediate Algebra, English II (Writing and Reading), Biology I, US History. The exam counts 20% of the final grade)

High School Final Exams

Exams will be based on the course standards.

National Assessment of Educational Progress-(NAEP)

(Random sampling of students for each group assessed. Reading-4th & 8th, Math-4th & 8th, Civics-8th, US History-8th)

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
