The Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 16th, and took care of the business of the district including first looks at the designs for the new Brazoswood HS and SFA STEM Academy.

AWARDS/ACHIEVEMENTS/RECOGNITIONS

- Eleven BISD Schools Earned 31 TEA Distinctions - The Board recognized the eleven BISD schools that earned our district 31 TEA Distinctions, with three campuses earning all of the TEA distinctions available. These 11 campuses earned more than twice the number of state distinctions this year as compared to last school year. As a result, staff members of these campuses will receive additional pay for each distinction their campus received. The BISD Board approved an additional \$200 for professional staff and \$100 for support staff for each TEA distinction earned by their school. BISD schools setting the standard for educational excellence through earning these TEA Distinctions:

- Freeport Intermediate School - Six Distinctions (of the seven eligible)
- AP Beutel Elementary School - Five Distinctions (earned all eligible)








- The Slade Field House

 - Construction documents are being finalized then our Construction Manager at Risk, Stewart Builders will take it out to bid
 - A guaranteed maximum price will be ready for board approval in October



- The Schematic Design for Brazoswood Main Campus and CTE Building
 - The designs for both facilities are complete
 - Brazoswood teachers & staff spent 8 days on the design and development
 - The site plan is still a work in progress, waiting on the traffic study and drainage requirements

- The floor plan is still being reviewed for Mechanical, Engineering and Plumbing needs and overall efficiencies
- Also, Stewart Builders is working on a construction phasing plan as this will be a multi phased complex project
