## New Ideas:

- 1. Suggest other related issues before publishing/submitting the new issue.
  - To avoid discussing the same issue over and over again.
  - I don't know how we can do this but I think when the user adds the tags, the relevant issues will appear on the side.
  - Maybe before submitting the issue, a prompt will show something like "Do you want to check these related issues before submitting?" or "We found a similar issue like yours, do you want to check it out?"
- 2. Add tags aside from color coding (not sure if we discussed this already)
  - To categorized them easily
  - Can be used as criteria for identifying its severity
- 3. Vote feature to move the issue from in progress to solved
  - Just like how the voting works in verifying the issue from the start
- 4. Put limit on how often a user can comment on issues
  - Having the Top Thinker feature will lead to a great competition— urging everyone to try to comment on every issue, so it is best to set limits.
- 5. Have the 'Expected outcome/ resolution' when submitting issue
  - To guide the other users on how they can help and to have direction instead of just showing solutions that are not contributing to the end result that the submitter wants.
- 6. 'Save as draft' feature for submitting and commenting on an issue.
