March 4, 2021

Galen Svoboda called the meeting to order.

Members present were: Dori Hoffman, Tyler Legate, Galen Svoboda, Chris Delka, Renee Peters, and Julie Wragge.

Also present were Deacon Doug Tunink, Marilyn Blunck, Daryl Kollars and Kim Spieker.

Altar Society - Meeting was scheduled for March 18th. A request was made to purchase another ice cream maker. The Council unanimously voted (Motion by Legate, second by Delka) to purchase another ice cream maker with the current age and output needed for the 150th celebration this year.

Cemetery - No update on paving the cemetery path.

Environment - Rick and Ron K. will be working on an area by the St. Joseph statue. The Foresters are donating auto hand sanitizer stations, and 2 TV's for the religious education program.

Finance - The fiscal comparison report was distributed. Motion by Legate, second by Peters for approval.

Knights of Columbus - No report

Maintenance - Daryl presented options for the basement window replacement in the rectory. Legate made a motion, second by Delka, unanimous vote to approve the purchase of 2 ProVia windows to be installed by Daryl and Sid Sudbeck. The back deck on the rectory needs replacement as the current railing is a safety hazard. Legated moved, second by Hoffman with unanimous vote to replace the deck with the Knights splitting the cost. The cracked concrete next to the hall by the alley was tabled for a future meeting discussion.

Religious Ed/Youth Ministry - Confirmation was scheduled for March 22 in Randolph. There are 45 youth being confirmed.

Spiritual Life & Worship (Liturgy) - Met on Tuesday, March 2. The group is getting ready for Easter. March 19th is the feast of St. Joseph with adoration being help from 12-7pm and mass at 7pm. Around 30 people from all the parishes are participating in the consecration to St. Joseph. The traveling trunk of St. Joseph's treasure will be circulated to each of the parishes for people to buy trinkets, etc. The sign up sheet to become a greeter is posted in church. Betty is working on the new ministry list.

New business - The Council looked at purchasing a larger outdoor statue of St. Joseph with a grotto and pedestal. Wragge moved, Legate second, unanimous vote to moved forward with pricing a statue package
