Again, self-nominations are warmly welcomed, and the committee is open to students, faculty, and staff. Nominated candidates can be new to the Theatre Program, or they can be returning community members. They can be Theatre majors, Theatre minors, or people who plan to participate actively in the theatre program in some other way. After we have a slate of nominees, there will be a period in which all nominees will be asked via email to submit answers to a few brief questions (to be submitted via a Google form link no later than September 18th). Those responses will be reviewed by Kelly Howe as the current faculty coordinator of the DEI committee and at least one other party to be determined. As in previous years, however, the other party will also be someone else with experience in DEI work, whether a faculty member of the current committee, a member of the DFPA DEI Committee, or someone affiliated with and trained by the Loyola Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Liaison (DEIL) Program. Following a brief review, nominees will be notified about the results of the application process.
