

STUDENT/PARENT TECHNOLOGY USE AGREEMENT

In this agreement the "District" means the Carlsbad Municipal School District. "You", "Your", and "Assigned User," means the student enrolled with the District and his/her parent/guardian. The "Equipment" is specific to technology use, such as a laptop or Chromebook, including power supply that is owned by the District and/or managed by the Technology Department for the District. A "Report" is an incident documented within two (2) business days.

1.1.1. Terms: Receiving Technology Equipment:

1. The Assigned technology equipment will consist of either:
Option 1 – one (1) Laptop computer and one (1) HP Brand Power Supply; or
Option 2 – one (1) Chromebook and one (1) Chromebook Power Supply.
2. As an Assigned User, you agree to be responsible for any losses and non-warranty damage caused to the equipment while assigned to you.
3. As an Assigned User, you agree to abide by the District's Acceptable Use Policy, Internet Safety instruction, and provide appropriate use, care and storage to keep the equipment safe while assigned to you.
4. Upon transfer disenrollment, or the end of the school term with the District, all assigned equipment will be returned to the District's Technology Department for repair assessment and/or storage.

1.1.2. Decoration:

1. Decorations, such as stickers, covers, magnets, graffiti, keychains, or any other adhesive decor are strictly prohibited from being placed directly on assigned technology equipment.
2. Assigned technology equipment may NOT be decorated, or altered in any way from their original condition and must display the aluminum Asset Tag at all times.
3. In the event decoration, graffiti or willful destruction of the technology equipment is present, an Assigned User will be subject to Section 1.1.6 of this Agreement and any applicable District Policy for vandalism of District-owned property.

1.1.3. Agreement Compliance:

1. As the Assigned User, you agree to comply with all rules and regulations contained in the District's Student Policies, associated Student Regulation Handbooks, and Acceptable Use Agreements, incorporated herein by reference, and made a part hereof for all purposes.
2. Assigned Users that attempt to access the inside of the equipment for any reason, including purposes of attempting repairs or to circumvent security will void all agreements for use and be subject to Section 1.2.2. and any applicable discipline in District Policy.
3. Assigned Users should charge technology equipment nightly and leave power adapters at home. Power adapters are considered the Assigned User's responsibility and will be subject to Section 1.1.5. of this Agreement, unless Section 1.1.9. is applicable.
4. Unauthorized media and applications such as, but not limited to: Flash or Java based games; movies; inappropriate videos, music, or images; and games not used for classroom instruction while attending District classes is strictly prohibited and will be subject to disciplinary action at the classroom, building, or District levels.
5. Assigned Users will not share passwords and will always access the technology equipment and network applications using their own login username and password only.
6. As an Assigned User, your right to use this technology equipment is conditional upon your complete compliance with this Agreement and incorporated policies and handbooks of the District.
7. Failure to comply with this Agreement may result in disciplinary and/or legal action, restricted computer access, equipment removal or other consequences as determined by campus and District administrators.

1.1.4. Title/Ownership:

1. The technology equipment and all digital files, documents or media, created or installed, and contained therein, belongs to or is under license to the District, at all times.
2. The technology equipment installed software and storage space is provided to Assigned Users for education and instruction, and does not grant ownership or Privacy to the User.

1.1.5. Loss:

1. For any technology equipment that is lost, stolen, vandalized or otherwise damaged, the Assigned User must report the circumstances within two (2) business days to the District's Technology Office, where it will be documented in a Help Desk Ticket. The Assigned User will receive instructions from the District on any other actions to take regarding the assigned equipment.
2. The Assigned User will be responsible for the full cost of replacement equipment, unless the District determines Section 1.1.9. of this Agreement applies to the circumstances.
3. Any equipment determined to be missing and unreported will be considered "Lost". A missing alert will be activated, and a Police Report will be filed by the District for the return of the equipment. The Assigned User may be held responsible for the full replacement value of the missing items.

1.1.6. Damage:

1. All damage to technology equipment must be reported and documented in a Help Desk form, available on the District website, or through a Help Desk Ticket submitted by a teacher along with the technology equipment delivered to the District's Technology Department to schedule a repair.
2. The Assigned User will be responsible for each reported repair that is not covered by warranty, consistent with normal wear or known to be a defect. Damage or loss of any technology equipment may be billed as separate incidents.
3. Assigned Users submitting multiple repairs may be held responsible for the full repair or replacement cost, if a pattern of abuse, mishandling, or neglect is determined.
