- What type of funding will you receive for Fall and Spring 2021
- If you are a TA or RA or GA, what is your preferred method for working?
- Where do you plan to live starting this summer?
- What kind of research/creative work do you plan in the 2021-22 academic year?
- How many semesters has COVID delayed your enrollment or application?

Satisfaction

- How satisfied are you being a graduate student at FSU?

Program Quality

- How would you rate the quality of your academic experience?
- How would you rate the quality of your professional development opportunities?
- How would you rate the quality of your student life experience?
- Helpfulness of staff
- Overall program quality
- Amount of financial support
- Quality of academic advising and guidance
