

Uniform and Equipment

- ⇒ The Classic Uniform of The Kingsguard; Steel Armor with Gold and Silver coloring throughout the armors different sections. The Helmet is specially sculpted to give the Guard wearing it an extra blade; this one on their Head. Both pieces on the Helmet that jut out are sharp and if one was to take their Helmet off they could use it as a weapon itself if the need arises and they are desperate enough, however one individual was said to headbash in their fights on occassion with them. Each set of Kingsguard Armor comes with a Green Cloak to cover themselves with, with Green and White Standards to drape from their waists. In recent years however with Cathal as Lord Commander, changes are allowed to be made to the standard armor given Cathal is more open with his rules, as he himself refuses to wear the armor of the Kingsguard and instead wears his own. The most changes that have been done currently are some removing their helmets at times and maybe replacing the armor under the cloak and standards.
- ⇒ As for Equipment, each Kingsguard was expected to wield a Spear in hand and a
 Broadsword sheathed and hooked on their Belts at all times. With the current Lord Commander

however, if one is more comfortable swapping the Broadsword for another Blade, he has made exceptions, although he prefers the Spears be kept he may also let a Kingsguard replace their Spear with another long-reaching weapon to replace it. At minimum, a Kingsguard needs 2

Weapons they're skilled with at any given time.



Purpose

- ⇒ A member of The Kingsguards is expected to serve their Lord with Devotion and Utter Loyalty; swearing Oaths that one who breaks said Oaths can find themselves at the chopping block of The Lord Commander. Their Job is to Serve and Protect The Royal Family, in present times that means The empress, they are seen at the Heels of their Ruler ready to Kill and Die for them. When not at the Rulers Heel, they can be found throughout the Home of their Ruler making sure dangers that may come to harm their Royal are warded off and taken care of before they can pose any real threat. Ultimately, they also may find themselves doing more than just doing their Guard duties if their Ruler, currently Queen, or Lord Commander commands them to.
- → One role the Lord Commander plays alongside leading The Kingsguard, is the role of The Executioner of Naath, their Blade being the one to take the life of those who are sentenced to death.



⇒ The Emblem of the Kingsguard Is the Shield and Sword of the first Lord Commander; it has not been changed since its first being made. This symbol has also been made into a broach of sorts, and the Lord Commander usually has it pinned somewhere on their person, usually under their armor, however they have it shown more openly for Council Meetings.

Lord of scrolls

The Lord of Scrolls is a Scholar who keeps record of all that goes on in Naath in their time, as well as preserves all the works of the Lord of Scrolls before them. They are in charge of the largest library in Naath in the Palace itself. They have a small force whome guard the library from any who may damage it, as well as keep the section dedicated to the secret works that may be stored away from former Scholars and keep them from the light of the public. They are sometimes refered to as the Keeper of Secrets as The Lord of Scrolls is usually the only one who knows some knowledge of what is commonly only known by a Ruler. Their day to day however is being responsible for records, documents, and files, as well as going through every document that passes through the Kingdom. 
