OPENING

[This meeting was a Seawell Elementary School PTA Members meeting held during Curriculum Night. The slides for the presentation can be found [here](#).]

The meeting began with Principal Kulikowski introducing the Seawell team who were present including Assistant Principal Estacio, the teaching staff, and the support staff.

The president (Scarlett) then began the presentation for the parents, guardians, and families in attendance.

As this was Curriculum Night at Seawell Elementary, attendance of parents, guardians, families, and teachers was not taken. Approximately 75 people were in attendance for the presentation.

PURPOSE [[Slides 2 and 3](#)]

Scarlett gave an overview of the makeup of the PTA Board Members (including Keith Starr and Clay Harris who would be voted in later in the meeting) as well as an overview of the many ways the PTA hopes to support Seawell. This includes providing PTA memberships for all teachers as a demonstration of the commitment to collaboration and support of the teachers of Seawell.

Encouragement was shared to all in attendance to consider joining the PTA with a purchased membership and to be involved in the many events run by the PTA.

BUSINESS [[Slides 4 and 5](#)]

The goal of the next part of the meeting was to vote on the Seawell PTA budget for SY2526 and to vote in board members Keith Starr (secretary) and Clay Harris (treasurer) and also to add Clay Harris to the PNC bank account.

- Previous Meetings Minutes
 - A motion was made to approve the minutes from the 9/3/2025 PTA meeting. The motion was seconded. The motion passed.
- PTA Board Membership
 - A motion was made to vote on Clay Harris' role as treasurer and to add him to the PNC bank account. The motion was seconded. The motion passed.
 - A motion was made to vote on Keith Starr's role as secretary. The motion was seconded. The motion passed.
- Budget
 - Scarlett shared some context around the creation of the budget for the 25-26 school year including changing the financial software used to manage the budget (saving ~ \$1200) and making the budget more transparent and simple to digest. Copies of the budget were shared with all in attendance and posted with explanation to www.seawellpta.com/budget.
 - Additionally, it was shared that an increase in fundraising would need to be achieved in order to meet this budget's expenses. An invitation was shared with all in attendance to be involved in the process of raising funds in order to support the work of the PTA.
 - Questions asked by attendees:
 - Does this budget include the opportunity to bring in speakers/visitors to the school?
 - It does not yet include line items for that. However, if more revenue is identified for this purpose, then an updated budget can be developed and voted on midyear.
 - Are we able to see last year's budget?
 - All past years budgets are posted on www.seawellpta.com/budget. The previous budget had room for improvement re: clarity and readability. All are welcome to peruse.
 - A motion was made to vote on the budget. The motion was seconded. The budget passed unanimously.
