

Speech@NYU POS Creation Process

1. Submit your deposit.

2. Ensure you have activated your NYU Email address right away.

- a. *All students will receive important onboarding instructions via their NYU email. Students applying to the Bilingual Extension Track should pay extra attention as relevant deadlines associated with the application process will be communicated via email.*

3. Students receive the “Syllabi Survey”.

- a. Syllabi Survey- a survey collecting all information necessary to create your Plan of Study
 - i. Foundation Course History / **Foundation courses still in progress**
 - ii. ASHA Course History / ASHA courses in Progress
 - iii. Program Preferences (e.g. Intensive track (on-campus only), study abroad, thesis interest, etc.).
 - iv. Information to support your Foundation Courses and ASHA courses- Course descriptions and Syllabi.

4. Syllabi Survey Review

- a. The supporting information you submit to the syllabi survey is reviewed by faculty to determine whether the foundation courses and ASHA courses you submitted meet the program's requirements.
- b. NOTE: Foundation courses cannot be reviewed outside of this process. Students trying to determine whether the courses they submit will meet the requirements should use the **CSD Foundation Course Equivalents** sheet to better understand course equivalents.

5. Advisors create your Plan Of Study.

- a. Once the foundation review period has ended (including the summer course review period), advisors will create your individualized Plan of Study.
- b. You will receive your Plan of Study ahead of New Student Registration.
