Abstract

The abstract must be written in English in MS Word format. The maximum length allowed for an abstract is 250 words. The title, author names and affiliations are not included in the count. The abstract must include the six (6) elements: title, author name(s) and affiliation(s), background and objective(s), methods, results, and conclusion. The abstract title should be concise and clearly convey the subject of the abstract and written in 12-point font Times New Roman, centred on page with single line spacing and bold. The author's full name(s) should use 10-point font Times New Roman, centred on page with single line spacing. A comma between authors and superscript a, b, c etc. to indicate affiliations (department/school, institution, postcode, city, state and country) should be used. The presenting author name should be underlined. The full name and email for correspondence should be provided. The author(s) should briefly and clearly describe the background and objective(s) of the study, methods, results and conclusion. The text should be left and right justified and written in 12-point font Times New Roman with single line spacing. The author(s) should detail the experimental methods and processes employed in the study. The author(s) should describe the precise findings of the study. The author(s) should describe a logically sound conclusion and reliable inference drawn from the results. (220 words)

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
