### **Meeting Minutes**

- a. **Discussion Item 1**: Data Discussion
  - i. Graduation Rate: we broke 90% for the first time ever!
     4 year graduation rate = 90.6% (328 students). This was a goal on our CIP to continue to maintain / improve the graduation rate.
     We had a 10% increase in graduation rate for our Students With Disabilities (from 75.4% last year to 85.5% this year). Having a second SELT helped us increase this percentage.
  - ii. 2024 GA Milestone Results- Algebra:

**Proficient and above** = 31% (up from 16.1%)

Developing and above = 66.8% (up from 47.7%)

Hopefully, the trend is that students will continue to be more prepared for their high school math courses.

**Our SWD improved significantly** 

<u>Proficient and above:</u> Last year-4.3%, This year 14.5% <u>Developing and above:</u> Last year- 21.3 %, This year 40%

- iii. 2023-2024 IB and AP: We examined the percentage of students scoring a 3-5 on all AP courses, and we saw mostly gains across the board with some exceptions.
- iv. College Enrollment-We examined the persistence rate of student enrollment in college and talked about how the exposure to AP and IB courses helps prepare students to be successful in college. Unfortunately, the persistence rate is unclear since the dip in our school's persistence rate in 2019 and subsequent graduating class statistics are unclear. We discussed the need for alternate data assessments for what post-secondary success looks like- other than 2 year and 4 year university/ college graduation.
- b. **Discussion Item 2**: Continuous Improvement Plan
  - i. Do we need to shift our priorities on the CIP Plan?
  - ii. Are all CIP Goals reflected in our Strategic Plan?
- c. **Discussion Item 3:** School Strategic Plan Alignment and update

     We discussed adding an update which prioritized student voice/ involvement / engagement / intentionality.
  - ii. We, as a GO Team will need to rank our priorities on the Strategic Plan during our next GO Team meeting.
  - iii. Review Priorities: We discussed emphasizing student voice and engagement and addressing barriers to student engagement. We also discussed new ways for students to understand their options in terms of dual enrollment,
