Keywords, 3-5 words or phrases, it represents the article content and should include words found in research database.

INTRODUCTION (12 TNR)

- The important issues in general and specifically encountered
- Explain research that has been done from the references the latest international journal (last 5-10 years), relate it to the plans to be implemented, and explain what has not been

done (research gap)

- Explain the solution offered, the importance of research conducted
- Explain the research purposes
- Explain the benefits to the science / society

METHODS (12 TNR)

• Explain the research methods, by step steps systematically according to the objectives, ending with data analysis.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (12 TNR)

- Results and discussion are combined in one part. It contains:
- The results of the findings to answer the research objectives
- Figure and table should be clear and the description must be concise and clear
- Discussion must reveal the in-depth analysis of the obtained results it is critically and in-depth synthesis accompanied by proof of evidence related latest references.
- Use international journals that are related to the topic and are the latest (5-10 years). Discuss the research results with the research results from the journal references.
- Explain the novelty of your research
- Explain the benefits and contribution of research for the science/ society

CONCLUSION (12 TNR)

- It is written in one paragraph without numbering.
- Answering the research objectives
- Explain suggestions for future research that have not been examined in this study

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT (if any) (12 TNR)

• Addressed to the person /organization that has been contributed in the research, e.g. funders of certain agencies or research assistance or language and paper editors

REFERENCES (12 TNR)

- Written alphabetically, using the "APA" style, Use manager references such as Mandeley, Zotero or Endnote
- References contain at least 80% refers to the primary references / research journals and the latest sources (at least 5-10 years). the number of references is approximately 30 references.
