Prepare to Travel to Your Course

(Further details following)

- 1. Submit your health form on your <u>Dashboard</u> as soon as possible. Once NOLS clears it, you can start booking travel.
- Book your travel.
 - a. We recommend that you make your travel plans as soon as possible after the Admission Office clears your health form.
- Arrange ground transport for before and after course
- 4. Arrange accommodation for after the course
- Complete and submit Travel and Logistics form on your <u>Dashboard</u>
- Consider Tuition Protection coverage (see <u>Dashboard</u>, highly recommended)
- 7. Check your medical insurance coverage will be adequate for your travels and expedition activities
- 8. If you are traveling from outside the United States:
 - a. Check that your passport is valid for the appropriate dates
 - b. Arrange visa and/or parent letter if needed
 - c. Notify your bank/credit card company that you will be traveling internationally
 - d. Get cash in local currency
 - e. Prepare for important cultural considerations
 - f. Get inoculations as required

- Minimizing risk of exposure to COVID-19 while traveling (follow CDC recommendations <u>here</u>)
 - a. Practice physical distancing (6 feet) when possible.
 - b. Wear a mask when indoors or in close contact while out of doors
 - c. Wipe down surfaces with disinfecting wipes before touching
 - d. Practice meticulous hygiene with frequent handwashing and hand sanitizer use

Welcome to NOLS!

The following information provides some details on course logistics and planning your travel to the Southwest. We look forward to meeting you at the start of your course and hope the following information will help you arrive with a minimum of difficulty and expense.

Course Start

Please wait to make travel plans until after the NOLS Admission office clears your health form. Your course will begin at the **Comfort Suites at Sabino Canyon in Tucson, Arizona** on the course start date. NOLS staff members will meet you in the lobby at 7:00 a.m. After a brief introduction they will transport you to the NOLS Southwest campus to begin the day's activities. Given the early start to the day, please arrive in Tucson the night before the start date of the course.

Pre and Post-Course Lodging

Discounted rooms may be available for NOLS students at the Comfort Suites at Sabino Canyon. Please call the hotel directly for the latest NOLS discount information or use the link below. Tucson is a popular tourist destination and room availability and discounts may be limited. Please make room reservations as early as possible at the Comfort Suites hotel for the final night of your course.

Camping

For those individuals driving to Tucson, camping is a less expensive option than the hotel. There are numerous campgrounds on Mt. Lemmon in the Santa Catalina Mountains on the Coronado National Forest. Expect a small fee of approximately \$20 and bring water, as there is none on the mountain. Please remember that you still need to meet up with your group and NOLS staff members at 7:00 a.m. at the Comfort Suites on the day your course starts.

Airport Shuttle Options

Rideshare companies: Uber (<u>www.uber.com</u>), Lyft (<u>www.lyft.com</u>), and TotalRide (<u>www.totalride.com</u>) rideshare companies are available as shuttle options in the Tucson area.

The First Day

The first day will be very busy. You'll meet your instructors, fellow expedition members, and the NOLS Southwest staff. After an extensive course orientation, the remainder of the morning will be spent issuing equipment and preparing food supplies for the entire expedition. You'll depart for the backcountry early that afternoon or in the following few days, depending on specific course logistics.

The Last Day

On the final day of the course you'll be transported back to NOLS Southwest. Upon arrival, you'll clean all the group equipment used during the course and return any rental gear. During this time you'll also have an opportunity to purchase equipment or souvenirs from our gear store. After lunch, you'll debrief your course experience with a member of the NOLS Southwest administration. Later that afternoon, staff and instructors will join you in celebrating your success. There will be a graduation dinner where diplomas are awarded.

After you pack up for your departure, you will be transported back to the Comfort Suites hotel at approximately 6:00 p.m. This marks the official end of the course.

The last day will be very busy. Do not plan to depart from Tucson until the morning after the course end date. You will be responsible for making your own reservations for transport to the airport (TUS).

Receiving Mail

You'll be able to receive mail before and after your course while at the NOLS Southwest campus, but not while you are in the backcountry.

Other Communications and Contact

NOLS Southwest has public wireless and desktop computers with internet access for students while at the campus. There will be no internet access while in the backcountry or on the road to your course area.

As a NOLS student, you will not be able to be contacted by phone or receive email while in the backcountry. NOLS does not permit students to carry their own personal smartphones or personal locator beacons (e.g. Spot, Fast Find, inReach) in the field. In the event of a serious emergency at home, all efforts will be made to contact you in the backcountry.

Travel During Your Course

Please note that you may pass through a Border Patrol checkpoint while traveling to and from your course area in NOLS vehicles. Non-U.S. citizens should be prepared to carry original personal identification documents throughout the duration of their course, including while in the backcountry. U.S. citizens may carry a photocopy. Check with your instructors before departing for the field if this applies to your course.

Luggage, Valuables and Vehicles

Carry essential items onto the plane with you, including prescription medications, masks, and hand sanitizer and retain your baggage claim stubs. These are important tools for tracking any missing luggage. Upon your arrival at our campus, promptly inform the person meeting you and your instructors if you are missing luggage.

We have storage lockers available for you to store personal gear and extra clothing while you are in the backcountry. Please try to limit items to one or two duffels or suitcases, as space is limited. Your valuables (i.e., plane tickets, credit cards, electronics, and money) can also be placed in a separate lockable storage safe and held for you at NOLS Southwest. Although due care will be taken, **NOLS assumes no liability for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property while in our care.** You may want to obtain personal insurance to cover such items.

If you are driving to Tucson, free long-term parking is available at NOLS Southwest while on your course.

Prescription Drugs

If you are taking prescription drugs or other medication of any kind, please make sure they are listed on your health form and that you inform your instructors during your orientation meeting on the first day. This includes epinephrine for allergic reactions. If you are prescribed epinephrine, make sure you bring it even if you have not needed to use it before. Such information and medication could be critical in an emergency situation. You should plan to bring extra doses of essential medication with you in case some is lost or damaged in the backcountry.

Miscellaneous Expenses

You are advised to bring enough cash and/or credit cards to cover miscellaneous expenses encountered while traveling to and from Tucson. These potential expenses include lodging costs in Tucson before and after the course, airport shuttle fees, laundry, non-NOLS meals, and any other non-course expenses. There are several ATM machines within walking distance of the Comfort Suites hotel. **Suggested minimum: \$300**

If Delayed

If your arrival to Tucson is delayed and you are not able to make the initial meeting time, please do the following:
