

Study Guide: Spanish 1A Review Unit

The Spanish 1A Review Unit test is a written and reading exam, which means **spelling (including accents) and grammar are very important!** I highly recommend you study by looking over your notes or accessing the Class Notes online.

The test may include the following:

- **Conversational words**
 - Greetings and farewells (*hola, adiós, buenos días, etc*)
 - Asking and answering your name (*¿cómo te llamas?, me llamo*)
 - Polite responses (*encantado, igualmente, mucho gusto*)
- **Dates**
 - Days of the week (*lunes, martes, miércoles, etc.*)
 - Numbers 0 - 31 (*primero, dos, tres, etc.*)
 - Months (*enero, febrero, marzo, etc.*)
 - Proper grammar (*el NUMBER de MONTH*)
- **Times**
 - AM and PM (*de la mañana, de la tarde, de la noche*)
 - Numbers 0 - 60 (*treinta, cuarenta, cincuenta, etc.*)
 - Proper grammar (*Son las for 2-12 or es la for 1, dos y media, etc.*)
- **Adjectives**
 - Adjectives (*serio, gracioso, inteligente, etc.*)
 - Adject. agreement (*Rosa es seria, Pedro y Juan son serios, etc.*)
- **Ser (to be)**
 - When to use each (*I am = soy, you are = eres, he is = él es, etc.*)
 - What each of them are on the chart (*soy, eres, es, somos, son*)
- **Subject Pronouns**
 - Where they go on the chart (*yo is top left, tú, middle left, etc.*)
 - What they mean (*él = he, ella = she, ustedes = you guys, etc.*)
- **Conjugation**
 - -AR verb endings on a chart ("*-o*" top left, "*-as*" middle left, etc.)
 - -ER verb endings on a chart ("*-e*" top left, "*-es*" middle left, etc.)
 - -ER verb endings on a chart ("*-e*" top left, "*-es*" middle left, etc.)
 - Translation questions (*We run = Nosotros corremos, etc.*)
- **Gusta Expressions**
 - Translation questions (*He likes to run = A él le gusta correr, etc.*)
- **Infinitives**
 - With translation (see above)
 - Activities (*correr, dibujar, montar en bicicleta, etc.*)
- **Class materials**
 - What they are (*el cuaderno = notebook, el papel = paper, etc.*)
 - Adjective agreement (*los cuadernos rojos, la carpeta roja, etc.*)
- **Classes**
 - What they are (*la clase de matemáticas = math class, etc.*)
 - What you need for each class (*el diccionario -> español, etc.*)
