Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance:

Adam Porth, Idaho Chess Association (ICA) President, called the meeting to order at 3:05 pm.






We switched from Idaho Credit Union to USBank in July. Balance as of 12/14/2021: \$2808.23

Barry wanted discussion: Buckendorf Library. Barry would like to ensure that Idaho chess history is preserved into perpetuity as he has 100s of boxes of chess materials, books, and periodicals from players that have died. This information should be made available to folks. We need a physical location for this. Adam suggested a contract arrangement with the ICA. Jeff Price suggested an alternative or subsidiary organization be formed.
