### Guest Logistics

To make the early start as easy and relaxed as possible, we will be staying nearby the night before and warmly recommend the same for any guests wishing to attend:

Check-in: Friday 5 June

Meet in reception: 6:00 AM (tea/coffee available)

Short walk to ceremony: approx. 10–15 minutes at a gentle pace

Return to hotel: approx. 7:00 AM

Breakfast: served 7:00–10:00 AM

Free parking is available at the hotel and nearby.

Request a late check-out for noon and join us at the Sheraton for 2pm

Put your wedding dress on and join us for lunch at the Sheraton walk in your wedding dress. It's no different from walking if you were taking photos outside in your wedding dress. Everyone who wants to can repeat their vows with us before the rising sun.



### What to Expect

A short, relaxed ceremony at sunrise (approximately 20–30 minutes)

A scenic coastal walk—unhurried and suitable for most guests

Time afterwards for photos before returning to the hotel for a warm breakfast together



### Guest Comfort

The route is a straightforward cliff-top path, but may be uneven in places

We recommend comfortable shoes and a light jacket or warm layer. No need to dress up. Wear what makes you feel comfortable.
