Scheduling 2024-2025

The selection of high school classes is an important task and one in which you, your parents, and your school counselors should give careful thought.

It is essential that you decide which courses best fit your needs and register for them. Each year students are disappointed because a class they requested closes or cancels. Final decisions on class offerings will be determined by enrollment after board action.

Chardon High School offers several College Credit Plus (CCP) courses. CCP offers qualified students the opportunity to enroll in college courses and earn college credit.

The college preparatory program, accelerated, advanced placement programs and the career/technical educational programs are designed to guide students in selecting subjects that will lead them toward achieving their goals.

This activity will need to be completed no later than March 7th in order for you to access your ACT scores in your MyACT account.
