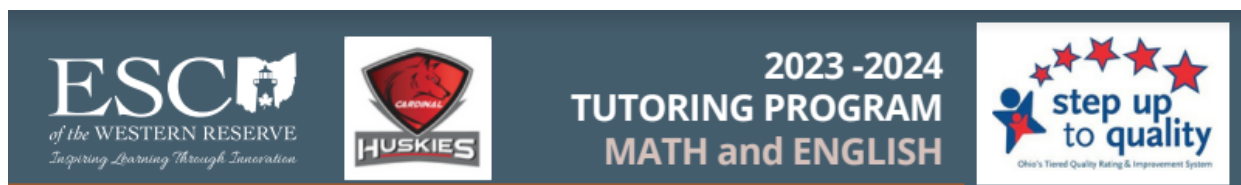
**2024 Common Application For Local
