<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Access your Drive via Launchpad 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click the 'waffle' in the top right of your Drive and scroll until you see the icon for Jamboard 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open a Jam by clicking the + icon on the bottom right. Once in your Jam, name it by clicking in the "Untitled Jam" box and typing your new Jam name. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To change the background, click on 'Background' and select the preloaded choices (lined and graph paper available). 	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the writing tool to draw. • Use the eraser to rid the board of unwanted work. • Use the cursor to select different tools and to move things on your Board. • Use sticky notes to add information. • Use images from your computer or the web to enhance your meaning. • Use shapes to add to your presentation. • Use textboxes to add polished words and sentences. • Use the laser to make a point that will fade. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To mark-up and image, select the Pen. You can adjust for width and color. • You can put the cursor (pen/marker, highlighter or paintbrush) anywhere on the board, including images. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To add a Sticky note, select the image and start typing your text. 	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To add shapes (angles) to your board, click the arrow next to the 'Circle' icon to select your shape 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To add other elements that are not easily made by shapes or drawing, insert images from the web by clicking the image icon from the menu. Search the item you want and insert in your Jam. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To add text to your Board, select the textbox and begin typing to add to your Board.
