Rotork Community Challenge 2022 is where our MSc students engage with local organisations and make a positive impact in the local community.

Some challenges are about awareness raising, some are about fundraising and some are about delivering specific events to service users.

Students apply to join a challenge in October, and we form them into groups of 7-8 students. Groups will then have until the beginning of December to complete the challenge and will then compete in a Presentation evening the week beginning December 12th, to win prizes for their charity (monetary donations provided by Rotork), which we would warmly invite you to attend.

The aim of the challenge is to help our students to develop employability skills such as team working, planning and interacting with UK organisations – all of which are valuable skills for their programme of study, CV building and job searching.

Time Scale:

- Application Deadline August 25th
- Launch Event – week beginning 10th Oct
- Students meet team members and learn about their challenge – 17th Oct
- Students contact their charity for initial meeting to understand more about the challenge
- Students make project plan
- Ideally challenge to be completed by presentation evening the week beginning 12th Dec
