Background: Suggested projects from conference brainstorming session

Goals to Accomplish:

- Enhanced Troubleshooting Quick access and consolidation of various views
- Collection Management Inform weeding/replacement decisions

Suggestions/Discussion:

- Related bug: Port Item Status Interface to Angular: (#1936233)
 - Builds upon work being done for Angular Patron Interface (lp#1904036)

PHASE ONE: (low hanging fruit)

- 1. Rename "Item Status" screen to be "Item Details"
 - Can be done before angularization let's do it now! (ACTION: submit lp bug)
 - May be able to implement before the Patron interface is completely done because Patron changes may go in as experimental.
- 2. Rename "Quick Summary" tab to be "Item Summary"

PHASE TWO: (more advanced stuff)

1. ITEM ALERTS, NOTES, TAGS

- > ACTIONS MENU (mid-tree fruit, ladder required for dev)
 - Add to list under Add > Add Item Notes and Add Item Tags
 - Add to list under Edit > Manage Item Notes and Manage Item Tags

> LIST VIEW (more significant changes)

- Change Manage Item Alerts to be a count move the "manage alerts" to Detail view
 - In the list view we could make the count number a link, instead of having a button to maintain that functionality.
- New Add Manage Item Notes (with the count as a link) also add to the Detail view for editing
- New Add Manage Item Tags (with the count as a link) also add to the Detail view for editing

2. RECORD SUMMARY

- > ADD ISBN (mid-tree fruit)
 - Show only one, with a "show more" option maybe the number of ISBNs in parentheses?

3. CATALOGING INFO Tab in Detail View

REMOVE "CATALOGING INFO" TAB (low hanging fruit)

- MARC record is accessible via Actions menu
- Wait until Angular port to avoid confusion

4. QUICK SUMMARY Tab in Detail View

Rename to "Item Summary" – listed above as low hanging fruit

> NEW STRUCTURE (more significant changes)

- General goal: Streamline list and make it sticky
- Add "Preferences" option to allow local field display decisions and save to workstation
 - Similar to Cataloging Preferences
 - Display all fields by default with an option to hide attributes at the consortium level in the staff UI the way you could with the XUL client - needs discussion
- Angular Port Page Design Suggestions
 - Would like essentially anything on Holdings Editor to be available on Detail View
 - Suggest making Item Summary tab mimic the visual beauty of the Holdings Editor
 - Circulation & Collection Management staff input needed about specific item attribute utilization and order of fields

> SPECIFIC FIELD-RELATED REQUESTS (mid-tree fruit)

- Breakout last cataloging edit into separate fields for edit date and staff account
- Move ISBN to Record Summary
- Add access to Item Notes
- Add access to Stat Cats
- Add Parts

> INTERSECTION with RECENT CIRC HISTORY tab (more significant changes)

- Move anything related specifically to the last circulation to this tab (ex: duration rules)
- Due date on both tabs (Summary) and (Recent Circ)
- Add rule ID (for duration rules, etc.) / matchpoint ID in addition to rule name

5. ITEM STATS Tab in Detail View (wishlist dev)

- New! tab for statistics
- Circulation & Collection Management staff input needed
- Move all creation/change history and circ stats onto new tab
- Enough details such as last circ date for staff weeding decisions
- Limit to Item-Level statistics for now
- Review pre-existing stats for currently availability to be updated
 - o All circ stats are currently item-level circs
 - Total circs and total circs current year
- Statistics Considerations moved to future planning:
 - o Handle with Reports for now & future Cataloger Dashboard discussions

- Any requirement for stats beyond single item circs
- Breakout circulation numbers (by org unit?)
- Bib level circs define as circulations for all items on that title
- Meta level circs??
- Local circs
- Remote circs
- Separate circs -- initial checkout vs renewal tracking needs?
 - Circulation & Collection Management staff input needed
 - Confirmed report is possible
 - o I think the idea was "count of total circs" and "count of total circs minus renewals"
 - Circ vs. renewal, not just circs, for collection development can be identified by looking at the Circ History List tab
 - Library need example: if it is an ILL, the state doesn't want renewals counted, just the initial circulation

6. RECENT CIRC HISTORY and CIRC HISTORY LIST tabs (needs discussion)

- Circulation & Collection Management staff input needed how are these used?
- Combine?
- Consider need for anonymous-ness
- Note: if you display 2 most recent circs and you "age" circs, the oldest (or both) circs in the tab will show dates and other non-patron info, but as Andrea mentioned, it'll note that it was an aged circ, instead of having the link to the patron.
- Note: Also worth keeping in mind that your aging and your "display X in the staff client" practices are completely separate from each other.
- Aging settings is a global flag, displayed circs is a YAOUS, by my recollection
- Aging circulations is a process that modifies the actual data in the tables. The "display most recent X" is a library setting that affects only how the information is presented in the staff client.

7. PERMISSIONS (needs discussion)

- Wishlist bug exists to make this more granular: not just the current "if edit barcode, can edit anything" https://bugs.launchpad.net/evergreen/+bug/1929593
- Need to create list of individual permissions desired

Other Related Bugs:

- All bugs with itemstatus tag (not to be confused with Item Status screen)
- Item Status screen missing Action "Show last few circulations" (#1754763) circ staff question
- Item status refresh after editing can get confusingly slow (#1821094) needs testing
- Can't add to Record Bucket from Item Status Detail View (#1952388) confirmed still true

- Item Alert Uses Old Interface in Item Status (#1960883)
- Marc edit option from Item Status (#1176927) can close this one
- Item Status Alternate View Needs Option for Next (#1609950)
 - Bug for paging in modals existing bug? Create if needed
- web client: Item Status Detail View Doesn't Remember the Tab (#1705790)
 - Discussed:
 - This bug about making the view "sticky" to return to where you were before
 - New bug? Allow preference for choosing default view; default should be "summary"
- Wishlist: Add an item status input box to the main splash page (#1778411)
 - Discussed:
 - New customization of main splash page would allow to add this as a link
 - Revisit to identify effort required
