- There is a new bar in the city. The new bar opens at six.
- There is a new student in our class. The new student is Spanish.

Used with superlatives.

- The fastest car is a Ferrari.
- The slowest animal is a sloth.

Used with oceans, rivers, seas and mountain ranges.

- The Indian Ocean.
- The Nile.
- The Atlantic Ocean.
- The Mediterranean Sea.
- The Himalayas.

Used with some countries when the name of the country has a noun in it.

- The Czech Republic.
- <u>The</u> United Kingdom.
- The United States.
