Leadership Development FLC

The Office of Faculty Development will be offering a Leadership Development FLC in Fall 2024 that will introduce leadership styles and strategies to current or potential leaders on our campus. This FLC is led by Dr. Holly Nevarez and is designed for people who are interested in developing their leadership skills. Through the series of six sessions, participants will explore a leader's role in staffing, shared governance, facilitating meetings, and managing difficult people. Individual participants explore their own leadership strengths, values, and beliefs to develop a leadership philosophy.

All faculty (tenured, tenure track, and lectures) who are interested in developing leadership skills should apply. New Department Chairs or Vice Chairs and other faculty who plan on serving in the role as future chairs are encouraged to apply.

Schedule:

All workshops will be offered in hybrid format. Participants are encouraged to attend in person but zoom will be available for all sessions. The six sessions will be held on these Fridays from 10:30 - 12: September 13, September 27, October 11, November 1, November 15, and December 6. By the end of the six sessions, participants will write a leadership philosophy.

Payment:

Faculty who attend 5 of 6 sessions of the FLC and complete the deliverable on time will receive a \$500 taxable professional development and training stipend. All faculty (T/TT and lecturers) are eligible to apply, but lecturers who also hold a staff appointment are not eligible for payment.
