

### In Ghent

Once you arrive in Ghent Sint-Pieters, the easiest way to get to the center is by public transport. Tram n° 1 drives every 15 minutes from the train station to the city center.

Ghent is a historic city with many views. World heritage in Ghent and must sees are:

- Ghent Belfry. Listen to the songs that play on it while walking around Ghent!
- Flemish Béguinages (There are two in Ghent, a small one in the city center, and one at the outskirts)
- Ghent historic town centre (on the nominative list of UNESCO)
- The Ghent Altarpiece, or 'The Adoration of the Mystic Lamb' by the Van Eyck brothers, completed in 1432, is recognized worldwide as a great work of art, and one of the most influential paintings ever made.
