

## College In the Schools (CIS)

If you have requested a CIS class for the 2023-24 school year, you should take this opportunity to apply to CLC. It is not necessary at this time to make a final decision if you are taking the CIS class for college credit, but applying to CLC now will save time. Applying to CLC **DOES NOT** lock you into taking your CIS high school class for college credit.

The following CIS classes are being offered next year at BHS through Central Lakes College:

- CIS Intro to Business
- CIS Intro to Accounting
- CIS Intro to Communication/Speech
- CIS Intro to College Algebra
- CIS College Algebra
- CIS Pre-Calculus II
- CIS Medical Terminology Independent Study
- CIS Human Biology
- Intermediate Spanish

There are two steps when applying to CLC. First, you apply to CLC, <u>Instructions for applying to CLC</u>. Please read and follow the instructions as shown and answer all questions as indicated. You will be applying for the Fall 2023 semester. You will be receiving two very important numbers during your application process, your STAR ID and your TECH ID. Please keep both of these numbers and passwords in a safe place as you will need to use them frequently.

When you complete your application, please complete the Student Information portion <u>CIS/PSEO Enrollment</u> form. Print the form, complete the form, and return to the BHS registrar at <u>stacy.littman@isd181.org</u>

Central Lakes College may require an AccuPlacer test for some courses. Please refer to each course description to see if the AccuPlacer is needed. The Acculacer can be scheduled at CLC by calling them directly.

Please note the following new GPA requirements:

- to qualify for CIS Intro to College Algebra, a student must have a HSGPA of 2.8 or higher
- to qualify for CIS Pre-Calculus II, a student must have a HSGPA of 3.0 or higher

The GPA requirements for all other classes is 3.0 for juniors and 2.5 for seniors.
