Gillion

I'm happy to see you okay too. You took that big daddy blast like a champion.

John

(Sighs) Yeah, sorry about that. Tried to get the jump on him, but he's always been a bit difficult to best and it looks like.... Captain! Where are you going?

Grizzly

He starts to swim. You notice that the Granberry pirate ship is actually turning at this point as he's swimming as best he can to catch up.

Gillion

A captain of his own fate. There he goes.

Grizzly

It looks like that their ship is beginning to peel off. Away from your ship and away from the direction Kira is going. To the direction that Jayson flew.

Gillion

Are we sure about that, team?

Charlie

Jay, are you still next to me in the water?

Grizzly

No, she's on the Albatross.

Bizly

I would also be on the Albatross. Right?

Grizzly

Yes.

Bizly

Okay. I will leave this Hwacha wizard to his own devices.

Hwacha Wizard

(Sighs)

Charlie

He's on our boat. Bro, what are you doing? He's a fucking enemy combatant.

Chip

All right, just make yourself at home. You know? Go downstairs, make a meal.

Hwacha Wizard

I surrender!

Grizzly

He falls over on his back.

Bizly

Earl will, make you some juice if you'd like.

Hwacha Wizard

Just don't kill me!

Chip

I'll catch up with you.

Bizly

I go over and I like tap his back.

Hwacha Wizard

Don't sell me!

Bizly

I run over to Jay.

Bizly

Jay, what's going on? We letting him go?

Jay

Yes, we're letting him go.

Bizly

[Crosstalk] Is he's letting us go?

Jay

Why wouldn't we let him go? He was going to kill us.

Gillion

Jay!

Jay

What?

Gillion

Gilly has an ask. Gilly has a question.

Jay

Uh-huh?

Gillion

I want the pin.

Chip

Oh, my God.

Gillion

I want the pin. But I can't see it. But you're really good at seeing. Can you help me?

Jay

There are like, three other things happening right now.

Gillion

I know, but the pin's gonna sink. And it's really helpful for fighting your dad.

Chip

Help him with the pin and then we'll talk about it. I got another problem.

Grizzly

They're getting farther away now. To where, any shouts and faces and just movement on the Grandberry pirate ship is muffled at best. But you can tell that Lizzie, although scorched and burned, is driving it at the helm and just beelining it straight to wherever he was going. And Kira, opposite direction, much further away as well. About 300ft or so.

Gillion

It'll be a helpful tool, probably for stopping whatever's about to happen. If you want... [Like a child] Jayyy.

Chip

I'll do one quick perception check.

Gillion

Jay, did you hear me about the pin? Jayyy.

Condi

[Die rolls] I got a natural one.

Gillion, it's gone.

Charlie

You motherfucker you didn't even let-

Condi

It wasn't going to change anything. I got a natural one.

Charlie

I was going to give you adva- Well, whatever.

Gillion

Okay, I'm coming back.

Jay

You can like swim for it, I guess. I don't know.

Chip

It looks like these guys didn't get the memo about letting him go then.

Jay

Yeah, and that's a problem, okay. And I also need to talk to Lizzie a little bit.

Chip

Why?

Jay

And also we need to get Gryffon back from Kira's ship.

Grizzly

Is Gryffon on Kira's ship?

Queen

Captains, I apologize. La, la, la, la, la. My aim was ruined by the fire that took over the ship. La.

Chip

It's okay. You did your best, Queen. Thank you so much for your service. We appreciate you. Can you go deal with the Hwacha wizard? I think he's trying to jump overboard.

Grizzly

He's like midway on the railing.

Chip

Please just pull him off. You know, get him something to eat.

Grizzly

[Sing-song] La, la! You will never escape! La.

(Laughing)

Gillion

That's right. That's right, Queen. Don't let him have hope. Jay, what do you want to do? Where do you want to go?

Chip

We can split up.

Gillion

We could try. Chip and I could row really fast in one direction and you could sail the boat in the other.

Jay

Okay. You guys... No, you guys follow Lizzie. I'll catch up with you. I'm going to go get Gryffon from Kira.

Gillion

Okay, I trust you.

Hwacha Wizard

Please take me with you.

Chip

Man, just go downstairs and have a cup of juice.

Jay

No-

Gillion

Sure. All right. You can come with us. All right, this one's coming with us.

Jay

No. I'm bringing him with us.

Chip

Can we please just keep him?

Jay

Why do you want to keep him?

Chip

I like him.

Grizzly

Every time someone gets near him, he screams.

Gillion

There's a void when Ollie left and I feel like he fills it, Jay.

Jay

He's annoying.

Chip

He's silly. Okay?

Jay

You are coping right now. You are coping.

Chip

He's silly! And I like him, and he stays! Okay?

Old Man Earl

Bitch is on some cofium. Copium.

Jay

You just miss Ollie.

Chip

Overruled!

(Wheeze laughter)

Gillion

Sustained. Wizard, do a spell.

Chip

Do it now. Don't make me look stupid silly wizard.

Charlie

This is so dumb. We should go.

Grizzly

Make a Con save.

Charlie

Wait. Me?

Grizzly

Yeah.

Charlie

(Laughs) [die rolls] Rolled a 13.

Grizzly

You take poison damage as he-

Charlie

Great.

Grizzly

Pee's himself and then casts Poison Spray.

Hwacha Wizard

There. I did it. Please don't kill me.

Gillion

Why would you do that to me?

Grizzly

He takes seven points of poison.

Charlie

That's like half my H- I kick him off the boat.

Chip

Don't kick him off the boat! Don't kick him off the boat.

Jay

Take him home now.

Chip

Gillion, can you. Don't focus on the Pee wizard. Teleport us there. Okay? Onto that boat.

Charlie

Is it-

Bizly

I point at Lizzie's boat.

Grizzly

You can get to Lizzie's boat with Vortex warp. That's what you're going for.

Charlie

Oh, okay, okay, okay. Alright. Well, I can only. Vortex warp someone else. I can't vortex warp myself. It's kind of a problem. What the hell? Okay, I'm sorry. I'm going to just. Vortex warp ship.

Condi

I'm taking the piss wizard, and flying away with him.

Charlie

No, I'm going to just. Vortex warp. Chip onto the boat with Lizzie. I unfortunately can't warp myself with that, so it just is what it is. And then I guess Jay's taking the piss wizard. I'm just sort of here on the boat. Toothboats are sailing away. Not much I can do about that. Go to the edge. Wonder where that pin is, you little bitch. No, I genuinely can't. I don't have the speed to follow either of them. I'm just going to be stuck here, so I might as well.

Grizzly

Well, your ship can follow them if you.

Charlie

Alphatross. Follow. Follow Gryffon. I'm just going to peer off this ship wistfully as we sail away, and if I happen to catch a glint in the ocean, so be it.

Grizzly

Yes, captain. Aye, captain.

Charlie

We have sustained a little over half.

Grizzly

Damage to the hull, although our sails, our ballista, our cannon and helm are all intact.

Charlie

Thank you, Alpha. Trust status on the woncha.

Grizzly

Captains, I cannot sense a wondra on the lower deck.

Charlie

Damn it. They caught us. Good. Before we sail away, I'm going to try and make one final not spiteful, like J. Perception check. Which I didn't think was a bad plan, but apparently I'm a hater.

Condi

No, it's a good plan. You're just bringing it. You're coming at me at, like, the worst time.

Charlie

If you'll allow me. I know, it's just.

Grizzly

Yes, of course I'll allow you. Make your. Go ahead and make a perception check. Very sweet.

Charlie

I'm going to Hans ability it. All right, here I go. Watch me. I've got plus one perception. Let's go. First rolls of six. Let's go. Second rolls of ten. I want this pin so bad. Going to use magical guidance. Check this out. Third roll of the D 20. Last one I'm going to get. Last one I'm going to get today. Here we go. That's a 17. I'm probably not going to do the pin.

Grizzly

Say it again. You're just peering over there wistfully over the ship, into the waters.

Charlie

Yeah, I was just looking into the water to see if I saw it, caught a glint or anything like that.

Grizzly

Okay, then you do not see it.

Charlie

Okay, all right, sorry.

Condi

We can maybe get like a pin from someone else.

Charlie

Not the same. It's not the same. It's not the same. Not the same kind of battle trophy. All right, I'm going to keep sailing, in that case, towards. Yeah, I'm just going to follow Jay.

Condi

With the boat and I'm going to fly.

Grizzly

You start flying. And albatross is behind. Albatross apparently flies about 60ft every round. I tried to do my best to do the math because the stat block only says 5. Doesn't say what it does, like, per round. So I just tried my best. So what's your movement speed, Jay? Per?

Condi

So I'm just like, matching the albatross.

Grizzly

Okay, yeah, 60, we'll say. The wind is just catching flawlessly in the sails of the albatross.

Condi

I can accelerate faster than a boat, so I get there first anyways, that's just how physics work.

Grizzly

Yeah, you also left earlier. Don't even worry about it. So, chip, you get vortex warped onto Lizzie's ship. And as soon as you do, you hear, oh, hey, welcome on board.

Bizly

As I'm blipped in, I'm mid scream. I watch Jay fly away with the watch a wizard.

Charlie

And I go, my silly little guy.

Bizly

And I'm blipped in halfway through that.

Grizzly

And then, yeah, of course, right as you're blipped in. Tip, make yourself useful and grab something, will you?

Bizly

Oh, caspian, hey, sure, yeah, grab something.

Grizzly

Help me with the sails.

Charlie

All right.

Grizzly

You take the other end on the other side.

Bizly

Pick up a rope.

Grizzly

All right?

Bizly

Oh, yeah, sure. And I go over and I'm holding the sails for a second.

Grizzly

All right. You guys are manning the ship as it is, tore like it is. Just trying to aggressively almost. You can feel like the ships tearing through the ocean just by Lizzie's aggressive driving.

Charlie

Good luck, Chip. Let me know if you see a small red pin. It's got like a silver back. Goodbye.

Bizly

You just hear like a bird, small.

Charlie

Yellow pattering on it.

Grizzly

You're helping out. You can hear just on the top of the gun deck where the helm is Lizzie not shouting anything, but you can just hear her fucking teeth grinding.

Bizly

I'm like, holding the sail and I'm like, helping them sail. And after a second I go, wait a minute, hang on, I didn't mean to be doing this. Lizzie and I run up the stairs. Hey, I think we're letting him go.

Grizzly

Damn fucking right we are. We are not letting that bastard go.

Bizly

Well, Jay said we're letting him go. She also says she want to talk to you.

Grizzly

Well, Jay is not the boss of me and I have a personal vendetta on that man. So I'm going to fucking chase him.

Bizly

Why? I got beef. But what's your beef?

Grizzly

Chip, now is not the fucking time as I'm busy trying to run this crew and catch up with the dragon man, the golden vice admiral.

Bizly

I didn't hurt you, okay? Don't talk to me like I hurt you. For one, two.

Charlie

There is no two.

Bizly

Don't be mean to me like that. Look, how about we just get him another time? He is weakened right now and this would be a.

Grizzly

Exactly. So why would I throw away that fucking chance to get back at them?

Bizly

I don't know.

Grizzly

You're doing great ship. You just gotta keep trying to talk her down. Thumbs up.

Bizly

I don't know. That guy showed up and tried to kill us a lot of times. And.

Charlie

She makes a good point.

Grizzly

Well, that's why she's the captain.

Bizly

I want to convince you to let him go, but I just don't have any solid reasons. Casme, can you help me out? Because I'm almost team. Go fight him, John. Anybody?

Charlie

Watch it.

Grizzly

Wait. He's like just finally. That's the sound he makes as he finally catches up to the ship. Somehow with his strength.

Charlie

Quick.

Bizly

Motherfucker.

Charlie

That is powerful.

Grizzly

Rolls an incredible strength. Check to increase swim speed. I guess he is a very good swimmer. He was a park R.A.F.T. at one point. Yeah. He splashes out and exhaustedly gets

onto the main deck. Got nothing. Shit this. And he gets cut off. Jay's the last fucking person I want to talk to right now. Not before I get a few words in with her old man. Chip. There's fucking history here. And honestly, it's none of your business. So you can either sit there and gawk.

Bizly

Okay, fuck you. It's none of my business. Like it or not, we're family.

Charlie

Bound.

Bizly

By that goddamn hole in the sea. Talk to me like a person or you're on your own.

Grizzly

Roll persuasion. Even though you always roll a 30. Just go for it.

Bizly

That is a 25.

Grizzly

She looks at you furious for a moment, frustrated as shit. And she lets out like a. And then just spins the helm all the way to the left, causing it to begin to turn around. Then she just storms off and almost kind of minimally shoulder checks you as she does down the steps.

Bizly

How?

Grizzly

Slams herself into the captain's quarters. Casme walks up to regain control with the helm.

Bizly

I'm going to walk down. I'm going to bust right into that goddamn room. The last time I checked, captains didn't throw temper tantrums. The fuck is your problem, ship?

Grizzly

Can you just fucking leave me alone for a second?

Bizly

No, I don't think I will.

Charlie

Because.

Grizzly

I don't have the patience at the moment to speak to you in the way that you are trying to get out of me.

Bizly

Okay, then yell it at me. Say it however you got to say it. Make me understand why you're acting like this.

Grizzly

She's, like, breathing heavily in and out and just pacing back and forth, and she opens up her mouth to say things, but nothing comes out. And so she slams her fists on a table and is just trying to regain composure to, like, you can tell, just get you out of this situation as efficiently as possible, but it's not coming together.

Bizly

All right? After a while of silence, if it.

Grizzly

Seems like silence and breathing for a second.

Bizly

Is there any drink in the room? Yeah, I'll walk over, I'll grab a bottle, open it up, take a drink, hand it to her. Don't think. Just drink.

Grizzly

She just keeps looking at the desk that she's planted her hands on as a way to gain some sort of stabilization or foundation, and then she just takes it without looking at you, throws it back, sends it back on a table.

Bizly

I'll just put this cork back in there.

Charlie

Okay.

Grizzly

Do you hear what he said?

Bizly

No. No, I was doing. I was fighting on the other side of the ship, doing stuff super epic and heroic. What did he say? Hey, come on. It's me. Talk to me.

Grizzly

I just made a mistake coming here to try to help. We should have kept our distance until the time was better.

Bizly

You and me.

Grizzly

Me from all of you.

Bizly

You're going to have to start making some sense here. Why? Why would you have to stay away? You made some kind of mistake. I'm sure it's okay. I'm sure we can work it out.

Grizzly

She swings around the desk and takes a seat in the captain's chair, and it just sort of looks like she doesn't know how to say it. He fucking blamed me for his daughter's death in front of his other one, Chip. And you want me to turn around and have that fucking confrontation when neither of them know what the fuck they're talking about?

Bizly

He blamed you? Why would he do that?

Grizzly

The whole government blames us, Chip.

Bizly

Why you specifically?

Condi

Because we were fucking there, Chip.

Grizzly

Is it not clicking?

Bizly

You never thought to mention this to me? I get why you wouldn't mention it to her, but to me?

Grizzly

You never fucking asked.

Bizly

I thought it might be a little relevant.

Grizzly

It's not something I go around in them wanting to share anyways. It's what we may be connected by the shit we went through as kids, but you haven't been with me for the last ten fucking years. A lot's happened. Call me a bastard if you want, but I don't like fucking talking about it. Rather, just move forward and use my power to set it all right. Because words do nothing but fill fucking dead air.

Bizly

Did you do.

Charlie

It?

Condi

Do what?

Bizly

Did you kill her? So there was an accident?

Grizzly

She can't look you in the eyes as her lip trembles. She looks off like she's reliving something deeply, deeply painful. No, but I might as well have. Jeb, I don't want to fucking do this right now. I don't want to do with you. I don't want to do with Jay. Tough shit.

Bizly

Because Jay heard what she heard and she's coming. If you talk about this with me now.

Grizzly

You'll what? Mediate? Or.

Bizly

I could help her understand. But to do that, I have to understand.

Grizzly

I don't even fucking understand, Chip. I'll give you the whole fucking story, but it won't make any goddamn sense because it still doesn't.

Bizly

I'm all ears.

Grizzly

And so we switch over to Jay, and you're flying at top speed to catch up with Kira and healing. Go ahead and roll another perception check.

Charlie

Jay, before you go, there's one thing I need to tell you. What? Let me know if you see the pin. I'm going to roll a perception check. That is an eight. I'm going to start recruiting people on the ship to help me. Queen, are you doing anything right now?

Grizzly

I'm going to look for the pin one more time.

Charlie

I sigh so heavily, ask the wizard if he's seen anything. But you know what? You know what? I'm going to pop another magical guidance. Let's try it. I'm running out of sorcery points. That's a 17 now. Again.

Grizzly

And you start recruiting people?

Charlie

I start recruiting whoever is on the ship not doing anything.

Grizzly

Dre pokes his head out of the bottom as you're shouting out. Is he gone, Dre?

Charlie

He's gone. But there's a critical part of the ferrin legacy. I need your help retrieving a small pin. A small, reddish, blackish, goldish pin. I know I dropped it around here somewhere. I dropped it. I just dropped all these. I'm sorry. I'm, like, going through. I don't think it's in the sea. It might have bounced off and come on the ship.

Grizzly

A reddish goldish whitish pen.

Charlie

It's sort of like, I think maybe bluish brownish. It's got one end that's sharp, that sticks in puddle. The horse comes up puddle, sniff it out and puts her head to the ground, starts sniffing for the pen. I'm just going to recruit anyone I can to start searching for this fucking stupid pen.

Grizzly

Okay, Earl. Earl does not help. He says my eyesight's bad. I'm looking busy, all right? I'm trying to patch up the bottom of the ship. And Queen says I can help, and I'm also driving the ship.

Charlie

It's okay, it's okay. I'm sure it's got self driving. Jay's very smart like that. Don't worry about it.

Grizzly

I'll drive myself.

Charlie

Earl, you said the bottom of the ship. That's a great place to start. Go to others, start looking.

Grizzly

Okay. So at the moment, still haven't seen it. But I did roll for them.

Charlie

We're getting closer. I feel it.

Grizzly

Next time you'll be able to roll with advantage.

Charlie

Wow.

Grizzly

Jay, as you begin to get closer, you're about halfway, maybe two thirds of the way to Kira's worship. And in your head, in the same vein. You hear, Jay. I want a compromise that keeps us both safe. I see you friends should not be on different sides. And, you know, of course, with the last time, the spell that you can speak back.

Condi

Hey, have you seen a.

Grizzly

Do you say that really? Fire the arcane cannon from her ship at you now.

Condi

Kira, you're the last person I want to fight, ever. I'm coming over in peace.

Grizzly

Also with wizard scene.

Charlie

Pin, that leaves you with exactly five words. If you have anything else that you'd want to say to Kira.

Condi

Also, have you seen Pin?

Charlie

I watch her get shot of the sky, die in front of me.

Grizzly

I explode earlier and like, fucking.

Charlie

Into the fucking water.

Grizzly

With that, one of the sails lifts up on the warship. You can see in the distance, and after a few moments, good few hundred feet, you make your way and you land on the deck where the helmet where Kira is standing. And you drop the wizard guy.

Condi

Yeah.

Grizzly

Or do you. I mean, what do you do with him?

Condi

I drop him. I don't want him.

Charlie

Oh, jeez. Thanks so much for not killing me. Scariest pirates I've ever seen in my life.

**Grizzly**

Yeah, okay. My God, he passes out.

**Condi**

Listen, I mean, Chip just offered you, like, a drink and some food, and I don't even think we were pretty hospital. With hospital.

**Charlie**

He always tried to poison me?

**Condi**

We don't actively keep poison on the ship. That would be really silly because then.

**Grizzly**

Second time.

**Condi**

Okay. Well.

**Grizzly**

Hey, Kira.

**Condi**

How's it going?

**Grizzly**

I'm glad you didn't stoop to keeping a prisoner of war.

**Condi**

We would never. Didn't even cross our minds.

**Grizzly**

And one on my ship. I'm assuming you want him not to go to jail.

**Condi**

Yeah, that would be preferable.

**Grizzly**

First of all, Jay, what the fuck?

**Condi**

Well, what do you mean by what the fuck?

**Grizzly**

Had you just met up with me when I offered to go off duty? I could have warned you about everything.

**Condi**

Well, it's not that simple, okay?

**Grizzly**

We could have talked about it. Maybe your dad wouldn't.

**Condi**

I mean, okay, but you had to understand. I had things I had to make sure got done. You're pretty important. I mean, my buddy Gillion, he was about to die. And we had a small boy who stowed away on our ship. Or I guess Marshall John's ship and then on ours afterwards. And we kept him around for a while, but we had to bring him home. I didn't want him to end up in danger because of me, because.

**Grizzly**

It.

**Condi**

Just would have been bad.

**Grizzly**

Okay. Seems like a terribly complicated life sometimes.

**Condi**

Most of the time, it's here. There.

**Grizzly**

So what are your goals, Jay? What do you want? Where are you headed? And what sort of deal or compromise we can reach to not fight to the death my crew. I just want these people to get back safely. And if your crew is hell bent on continuing a fight? They won't.

**Condi**

Well, I mean, we're not trying to continue a fight right now. We just want Gryffon back so we can just continue on our merry way and get what we need to do.

**Grizzly**

And where is that?

**Condi**

Kira? I'm gonna trust you, okay?

**Grizzly**

It would be nice. We did wear diapers together.

**Condi**

Me and my crew are heading to the Black Sea.

**Grizzly**

Nice? Why would you do that? She looks like genuinely shocked.

**Condi**

Chip. The bastard looking one?

**Grizzly**

The blue one? Yeah, kind of.

**Condi**

He was a little bloodthirsty. He was the one who wanted to try.

**Grizzly**

The one with the.

**Condi**

No, no, the other.

**Grizzly**

Easy. You know what I do is Gillion.

**Condi**

Has gills, so he's Gillion and Chip.

**Grizzly**

Do you have trouble remembering your friend's names?

**Condi**

No, I don't. It's just like, at the beginning of it all, it was a little tough.

**Grizzly**

I understand.

**Condi**

It's bad with names.

**Grizzly**

I mean, seriously, Jay, why? What do you mean, why? Like, black Sea or.

**Condi**

This life?

**Grizzly**

Because.

**Condi**

I mean, I guess I can explain both.

**Grizzly**

Stop there for a minute. All right? And she is going to remove a conchell from her. Inside of her, you were wired a pocket. She's basically answering it. And a voice comes through. You hear your father's voice. Captain Kira, I give you permission to report directly to the admiral. The pirates that we set out to arrest were let go. I take full responsibility.

**Charlie**

But I will.

**Grizzly**

Be taking a leave for a time. Do not engage any further. Should they haphazardly make chase. All right, sir. I'll let the admiral know. And it just hangs up. No, he wasn't wired, Jay. They don't work like that.

**Condi**

**Grizzly**

**Condi**

**Grizzly**

SHE SIGHS I'm going. I'm stepping over direct orders now to talk. And what I'm. I have to warn you, Jay. Yeah. I've always got a finnish sort of vibe from Vice Admiral Kenter. But that's why we wanted to join R.A.F.T., was to change it from within. And I don't make those decisions, so I can't do anything really, right now about him specifically. But what I can tell you is the eastern Sea is a no man's land now, and it's filled intentionally with some of the worst pirates and people of history.

**Condi**

I would just kind of look here and say we can handle it.

**Grizzly**

You're going to have a really tough time getting into Alport. Not without some kind of help or a plan.

**Condi**

Well, we have this mirror.

**Grizzly**

A mirror? Jay, what is that going to do?

**Condi**

I don't know. I mean, we can smuggle our ship in. I don't know. I don't think before I speak a.

**Grizzly**

Lot of the time.

**Condi**

Sometimes I just say things and I just think they'll work.

**Grizzly**

Well, from what I've heard, the admiral is a wicked tactician. And they've been allowing pirates to go into the Black Sea secretly for some time now.

**Condi**

You guys know about the beyond section?

**Grizzly**

I'm pretty sure that's R.A.F.T.. No.

**Condi**

That ruins the entire thing. Yeah, it's just gone now. It was so cool before. Now it's just like, government sanctioned.

**Grizzly**

I don't know for sure, Jay, but I'm just worried that I don't want to see you get hurt more. So complicated. But as your friend, I could help. As part of you not sinking my ship and this crew, I could help yours get into the city and do whatever you want. But that would be as far as this compromise will go.

**Condi**

Kira, I don't know if I can ask you to put your head on the line like that for us. I appreciate it.

**Grizzly**

I really do.

**Condi**

But you know what? And if you get caught assisting us, what happens then?

**Grizzly**

Maybe it's emotion.

**Condi**

Or you go to a military prison for the rest of your life. Like the block? Much more likely.

**Grizzly**

But if you try to get in. I don't know. It's more tight security than ever. Every entrance is watched. Every dock is paroled. Guess maybe your mirror could work. But I don't really know what you're talking about.

**Condi**

It's like a mirror that can. If a creature looks at it and somebody says the command word, they get stored in the mirror. Grizzly

From Jay, dumbass.

Bizly

Oh, right.

Grizzly

Okay.

Bizly

Sorry. It's just a lot of information I'm taking in right now. I'm just trying to really process everything that you're saying. Also, Ollie is Shadowbeard's son. Just want to throw that out there. I was looking for a spot to throw it in there and I didn't know where to do it, and so I just did it. And now you know that. And there you go.

Charlie

Okay.

Bizly

I'm going to go buy you some time. I love you. Is that weird? You're like my family.

Charlie

Okay.

Bizly

Goodbye.

Grizzly

You drop that. Her face kind of like, her eyes go wide, and then you just awkwardly dip out as we're going to switch back over.

Charlie

Dude, that was heavy. So, she hasn't seen the pen?

Grizzly

I was going to let you roll again, but not anymore.

Charlie

Wait, really?

Grizzly

You can if you want a world perception again.

Bizly

Dude, I can't imagine the DC is getting any better.

Charlie

No, I'm done. I give up. The fuck do you think I am? I'm rolling. Dude, just so you know, my perception is a plus one. So, really, this can, like. And I've been rolling consistently seventeen s. I feel like I need something good here. That's a five and a ten. I'm going to fucking burn another spell point. Come on, baby. Come on, baby. Natural 20. Natural 20. That is a 20. Not natural 19 plus one.

Grizzly

Unfortunately, you're not saying that.

Charlie

No. It's not even here, is it? Earl, status report? No, got nothing. You want a smoothie? Only if it's made out of pin. I shove my head in the sea, fishies return to me.

Grizzly

A few of them come back. Not all of them, but none of them seem. They kind of like, shake.

Charlie

No pen. No pen.

Grizzly

No pen. Brilliant idea, though, but haven't seen it.

Charlie

Okay, everyone, we're going to need to pivot. Okay. All right. If I was a pin, where would I be? Okay, I pull out destiny's blade goddess. I. Nikki, I'm going to try and use the. Wait, what's it? It's the fucking I'm sorry, I'm forgetting what it's called. The luxury pearl shard. I'm gonna try and. I'm gonna try and fucking do an arcana check to cast augury to ask the gods a question. Yeah, all right. Arcana check. I actually don't know what I need, but I'm going to roll it. I roll the twelve.

Grizzly

I think you have to ask it yes or no question, right.

Charlie

Is the pin in the water?

Grizzly

It says, better not to tell you now in the sand, in your mind's eye.

Charlie

What the fuck do you mean? I take out destiny's blade. You're praying on my downfall, aren't you? You're praying on it. Well, this is the red thread of fate. I see it here. And the thread is letting this pin go and we're going to cut right through it. I pull out the scroll of commune. Dude, really? You're going to use it here? You're going to use it here?

Bizly

You're crazy.

Charlie

I'm in too deep now. I'm in too deep now.

Grizzly

You contact your deity or divine proxy and ask up to three questions that can be answered with a yes or no. You must ask your questions before the spell ends. 1 minute. You receive a correct answer for each question. Grizzly

Question.

Charlie

I summoned God. Okay, my first question. Do you have the pin? No.

Grizzly

Okay.

Charlie

All right. I didn't actually think about my questions. Hang on. So does she just like fucking manifest or like, how does this work? Because that's fucking awesome.

Grizzly

No, you just ask the questions overneath the scroll. They would not just manifest.

Charlie

My fucking sword said, better not to tell you for the ocean. So I'm just going to ask this goddamn deity is the pin in the sea? Question one.

Grizzly

What languages do you speak? I'm kidding.

Charlie

What say I speak common and primordial?

Grizzly

Either way, it's not a voice that you hear or anything. It's more like senses and feelings. Almost like the same when you're doing augurie or the Lexus pearl shard where your vision gets pulled into the sand. This one is more just like confident feelings. And you feel it's not in the sea. No.

Charlie

Okay. All right, guys. Everyone. It's not in the sea. Okay, one more question. No, I get two more questions, right? You asked if they had the pin. I heard you, Earl. I whispered it. I didn't count it. That was a bit question DM. Did that count?

Grizzly

Okay, fine. Get two more.

Charlie

You can't tell me. I used to have a question to ask the goddess of the sun. She had the not. All right? That means by process of elimination, it's got to be on this boat. Or their boat. It's or their boat. We've got two questions left, okay? Either way, this second question will tell me which boat it's on. Because if it's not on this boat, it has to be on that boat. Grizzly

Charlie

Oh, they did turn around. You're right.

Grizzly

Okay, I see you can swim over there.

Charlie

I dive into the ocean and I start swimming.

Grizzly

Okay.

Charlie

I dive into the sea.

Bizly

You should look around while you're diving.

Charlie

Okay. Look around. No, it's not in the sea. She told me what is going to be kind of on the ship. What is? They lost kind of on the ship. It's kind of on the ship. It's kind of on the ship. I swim as fast as I can and I check the side of the hole.

Grizzly

I'll get back to you.

Condi

Kira.

Grizzly

Before I go.

Condi

When we were younger, we both agreed we would try to do our best. Change R.A.F.T. from the inside. I guess I just want you to know that that hasn't changed. I think my will. My will to try and do it from the inside died along with my sister.

Grizzly

I'm so sorry about your family, Jay.

Condi

Who was born with can't really replace them. I guess.

Grizzly

We may have different methods, but I'm confident you know what you're doing.

Condi

She just kind of gives a solemn nod at her. For what it's worth, I may be a pirate, but I am trying to put good out in the world. Just sometimes there's a little bit of chaos.

Grizzly

Well, as long as you're the one controlling the chaos.

Condi

I'll be doing my best.

Grizzly

Good luck getting into airport, Jay. I'll try to have a nice long conversation with the gods just ahead.

Condi

Just don't get yourself in any trouble, okay?

Grizzly

No, I won't.

Condi

Okay, I'm going to grab.

Grizzly

When he wakes up. Tell him better luck next time.

Condi

Yeah, I'm sure he'll appreciate that. Maybe give him the fire under his ass. Last time, actually, he was so high, he didn't even join the fight.

Grizzly

He's so big and plushy. But when I hit him, he's all soft. I think that's, like, how cute it was. So conflicting. And then he sounds like that.

Condi

He's like, yeah, and also his arm is a gun, so he kind of disarms you. With his voice, his general physique and just how he is. And then he speaks and shoots you.

Grizzly

And you're like, oh, shit.

Condi

You know, it's crazy, right?

Grizzly

Interesting bundle of people you've pulled together.

Condi

Yeah. Wait till you meet the rest of the crew. One day you have an old man who steps on fruit. Pretty awesome. Okay, I'm going to roll.

Grizzly

Yeah. Okay. Roll straight, Jack. He's so heavy. Not saying Jade isn't fucking jacked, but wow.

Condi

I actually got an 18. That's with a minus one.

Grizzly

I'll say, jay, you're going to move very slow, but you can hold him like a bird, like a hawk, and fly him off the ship. And if you do just that.

Charlie

I.

Condi

Do have vortex warp right now. I would vortex warp him onto the ship. Once that was close enough, do you.

Grizzly

Land right back on the Albatross? Yeah. Okay. It's just you whenever you land. Gillion is currently in the process of swimming too.

Charlie

You see him just swimming. So butterfly as fast as he can, away, straight towards a ship heading out of Queen.

Condi

Where's Gillion going?

Grizzly

Their ship is about 100 or so feet back behind yours now.

Condi

Okay, so I can see them?

Grizzly

Yeah. And Queen says, I'm not sure. Oh, to their ship. Yeah, we were searching for a pin. Have you seen it? Yeah. You can roll perception check.

Charlie

I swear to God, if you fucking see the bin, I'm going to lose my shit.

Condi

It was almost a natural 20. It was 19.

Grizzly

You don't see the pin? Yeah. Okay.

Bizly

Can I roll perception?

Grizzly

Yeah. Okay. So all at the same point, Gillion, you're swimming chip exits the captain's quarters onto the main deck of the grandpa pirates ship. Go ahead and roll perception. This is the last perception roll. I'm allowing for the night.

Charlie

His role is the. Yours is the last, bro. Let me catch, champ. It's your destiny to find the fucking pin. Guidance on him. This has to be it.

Bizly

Would you let me investigate for the pin?

Grizzly

It depends on how you're investigating. I'm not going to lie to you.

Charlie

I think my suspicion don't go off this entirely is that it just stuck where I originally threw it. Now, this would be really dumb, and I probably should have been the first place I looked, but it wasn't. Okay. It was not the first place I looked.

Bizly

I am going to think back to my memory of debris being flung from the ship and think about anything that could have been flung this way. And I'm going to investigate those several different spots in which the ship might have been struck and the surrounding areas roll investigation.

Charlie

I say eyes over the octopus Cabal. I want to also give him enhanceability.

Grizzly

So he gets advantage. You have to be touching him to do.

Charlie

My swimming speed is the same as my walking speed. And I dash. I want to use a dash action, dude. If it's not enough, I'll haste. If it's not enough, I'll cast haste. I'll use the last of my spell points. That's the last I have to cast haste. Yes, I cast haste. I go there as fast as I can. I cast enhanceability on him. I'm fully out of spell slots. I've used half of them on this fucking pin. I crawl up the side of the fucking boat as fast as I can. I slam my hands on the side of his head like Benedict Cumberbatch in Sherlock Holmes discombobulate. Boom. The fucking Robert Downey rings out from above him. His eyes begin to bulge and magnify and spread as he sprouts more and more. Eyes. Eyes. It was a mollusk. And now he has advantage. And a plus a stand right next.

Grizzly

To him, and I.

Charlie

Tell me. Tell me what you see.

Bizly

Okay, well, the first roll was a two.

Charlie

You don't even care, do you?

Bizly

Roll physical.

Charlie

You care so little. You roll so. No.

Bizly

Here, hang on.

Charlie

You rolled a 30 on everything else until. Dad.

Bizly

I got you.

Charlie

Are you ready?

Grizzly

Yeah.

Charlie

I can't tell you how much I feel like God is going to give me a one right now. I literally can't tell you.

Grizzly

We can see his dice rolling area.

Charlie

Look at that. He's rolling the dice. Curly's blow.

Grizzly

And it's a 14.

Charlie

Plus windy, four. Plus windy, four. Plus.

Condi

Also your modifier.

Charlie

Plus. This is all I have, dude. Plus 418.

Grizzly

Plus you.

Charlie

What's your investigation?

Bizly

Plus 624?

Grizzly

24.

Charlie

Come over here. I've given everything I have to the. Everything I have to the cause. I have nothing left to give. The tank is empty. I've got 13 hp. I asked the wizard to cast a poison spell on me to try and find the pin. That didn't work. I asked God, I asked my sword, I asked the ocean. I asked the fish. I asked everyone. And here I am at the end of the fucking.

Grizzly

Just sit down, buddy. Sit down, man. Just sit down.

Charlie

Not until I know, Chip.

Grizzly

You begin investigating the granberry pirate ship. After your tragically sad conversation as if it never happened, you walk out unscathed because you're already haunted enough.

Charlie

I was just looking around kind of.

Bizly

Look, but it spiraled.

Charlie

No, you're not going to kind of look. You're going to really look. You're going to really look forward.

Grizzly

You notice something?

Bizly

Can we have Charlie Deafen?

Grizzly

Yes, we can. Charlie deafin.

Charlie

I swear to God, I'm deafening. I'm going to walk away. I'm going to wait for you to at me. I won't even try to reach your lips. And I will take your word. I will take your word for whatever.

Grizzly

You fucking say at this point in the day. It's getting around sunset now, or just before the golden hour. But the sun reflects an orange glint on the person street across. Talking to Caspian, on the person of Marshall John.

Bizly

He has the pen.

Grizzly

He has the pen.

Bizly

I'd like to walk up to Marshal John, and I'd like to just take.

Charlie

It.

Grizzly

From his hand.

Bizly

Yeah, I'd like to go. Hey, John, can I have that, please?

Charlie

What?

Grizzly

No. I need this. Please. I've always wanted to have a fairing pin. It makes me feel important.

Charlie

Please.

Grizzly

Also, I don't have any magic, so.

Charlie

This should be sick. Pretty please?

Grizzly

What's wrong with Gillion over there?

Bizly

Oh, nothing. He's just being Gillion.

Charlie

You know what?

Grizzly

Even though I did tackle the va, I'll give it to you if you beat me in an arm wrestle.

Charlie

Okay.

Bizly

Just strength.

Charlie

All right.

Bizly

21 still.

Grizzly

I rolled, actually. Natural. 18. And you lose.

Bizly

Okay.

Grizzly

The arm wrestle.

Bizly

As I'm losing, I say, well, John, you did it. You did it. Good job. And I steal the pin. Secretly.

Grizzly

Roll.

Bizly

Okay. 21.

Grizzly

Okay. Steal it. Okay.

Bizly

I put it in my pocket.

Charlie

Winner.

Grizzly

Marshall Don starts cheering.

Bizly

I leave the room. I walk over to Gillion.

Grizzly

You're on the main deck. There's no room.

Bizly

I leave him. We're gone. I'm gone from him. He's disappeared forever.

Grizzly

Okay, Gillion. You watch him walk over to. So Caspian and Marshall John are having a conversation as the ships are just drifting at this point forward. And they're just kind know, shooting the shit. And then you watch Chip walk over to him as you're kind of, like, biting your nails and frantically looking around. And Chip's looking around. Chip walks up to him. He talks to Marshall for like a split second. They walk over to the barrel, sit down right next to where they were just talking. And then they have an arm wrestle competition. And now Marshall John is cheering. And he says, winner. And then ship just kind of walks back to you, defeated.

Charlie

Couldn't find it. Okay. And I step off the ship, and I go home.

Bizly

As you step off the ship into the water, you hear a splash next to you.

Charlie

I look at it with sad, watery, hopeless eyes as I sink down the depths of the abyss.

Bizly

It's the pen.

Charlie

I shit myself. Oh, my God. I take the pen. I miss. It falls down. I take the pen. I swim up and I look up. Thank you, goddess. I knew you'd come through for me. Thank you. Thank you. My prayers have been answered. I knew you'd come.

Bizly

I'm a great goddess.

Charlie

I have one more question. Are you my mommy too? Son? Thank you. I love you, mom. I start staring right into the sun. I love you.

Bizly

I write a note that says, mommy loves you too. And I throw it into the water.

Charlie

I don't even like secretly, I grab it.

Bizly

You can't tell it was me because there's literally no.

Charlie

I can't even roll high enough. I can't even. Rohine. I grab it. A message from the goddess. Open it up. What does it say?

Bizly

Mommy loves you too.

Charlie

I hold it so fucking close to. I hold it so close to my chest. I hold it so close to my chest.

Grizzly

This is the saddest thing to happen, this episode.

Gillion

You don't know how long I've waited to hear those words.

Charlie

And I hold it so close. And I tuck it into, like, a secret spot in my armor. For the first time a parent has ever told me that they loved me.

Bizly

Oh, damn, bro.

Grizzly

When he finds out it's you, there's going to be another ice arena and everything.

Charlie

(Laughing)

Bizly

Don't. Don't, don't- honestly, I wanted him to think he did it himself. Just like a paladin to give the glory to God.

Charlie

And I hold it up. And I say,

Gillion

Found the pin. Glory to the goddess.

Charlie

Hold it up,

Chip

Damn it.

Charlie

Radiant. Hold it up in front of the sun.

Chip

Good job, Gillion, and goddess.

Grizzly

For expedience. That bit is over. I'm saying. I'm telling you now, that bit's over.

Bizly

No, that's- I respect that. I respect that.

Grizzly

What are you all doing? In character, for real. After the bit? I mean, after the pin.

Condi

Jay is heading towards the Grandberry pirate ship.

Bizly

I'll also fill Gillion in on what I've learned.

Gillion

Wow, that's...

Chip

Deep as fuck.

Gillion

That's a lot. And what happens now? That's Jay right there.

Chip

Well, now we hopefully, I was thinking, distract Jay until tension kind of simmers down.

Gillion

It doesn't feel like really, the... Is that what you'd do?

Charlie

Stare right into the sun.

Chip

Dude...

Gillion

Ow. Ow. Ow. I mean, should we... Should we tell her? Who should be the one to tell her?

Chip

Well, no, it should be Lizzie. Right? But,

Gillion

I don't think we're going to be able to distract her. She's smart. She'll know what's going on. It just feels like a cool trick, right?

Chip

Yeah. She'll know what's going on. And then she's going to run in there and try and kill Lizzie before she can explain.

Gillion

Sure, Jay's a reasonable person. She would- Let's just ask her what she's planning to on. Come on Chip.

Chip

Okay, Gillion.

Gillion

You misplaced these worries. You misplaced these concerns.

Chip

Also, the pin was me.

[Total Silence]

Gillion

At least I have this.

Charlie

I hold the paper, so close-

Chip

That was me too.

Charlie

Again.

Chip

[Awkward] Old habits.

Charlie

Start shaping water into an ice- Yeah no. (Laughing)

Gillion

[Stuttering] Yeah, of course. That makes sense. Why would she...? Why would she. [Choked up]
Let's go talk to Jay.

Grizzly

At the same time, the ships meet the same speed. And actually it's Caspian who comes over and helps throw the plank over the two railings to connect them. As you did so, so, so long ago. And as he does, he says.

Caspian

Gillion.

Gillion

Caspian, happy belated birthday. I'm sorry you won't be getting my gift in the mail for a little bit. But I missed you, friend.

Caspian

You didn't have to do that, friend.

Gillion

But I really, really did. And more than that, you really inspired me when you sawed your boat in half and swam it for days on end. So recently, we were in quite the pickle. And I froze half our boat with Earl in it. Oops. And got it-

[Disgruntled old man]

Gillion

-back to shore. But I don't think I would have thought of that if not for you. So thank you.

Caspian

Brilliant. (Light chuckle) Brilliant stuff. Gillion. It sounds like you've been through a lot.

Gillion

A lot has happened since we last spoke.

Caspian

Honestly, we were. [Stutters] You know, I've tried to reach you some nights. Where's your shell?

Chip

He broke it.

Gillion

Oh... I broked it. Sorry. They have the phones now.

Chip

I got a new one.

Condi

Jay would be boarding the ship, like, as soon as she's able, by the way.

Grizzly

Yeah, okay. You do that. And kind of cut this conversation off with your presence.

Chip

Jay, hey!

Gillion

[Nervous] Hey, Jay. Where are you headed?

Chip

Jay Ferin.

Gillion

And with what intentions?

Chip

Reasonable and beautiful.

Gillion

How did things go? Reasonable, level headed, cool headed, powerful, commanding, and yet? Forgiving captain.

Chip

Do you want an Icee? We could go get you one right now.

Gillion

Are you comfortable?

Chip

You look like you need like-

Jay

I don't have time for that right now. Where is she?

Caspian

In the captain's quarters.

Chip

Dude.

Jay

Thank you, Caspian.

Gillion

Thanks, Caspian.

Chip

Jay, Jay, Jay. Before you go.

Condi

Jay starts walking. She starts walking.

Bizly

I grab her before she goes.

Charlie

Oh, shit.

Chip

Before you go in there.

Condi

She looks angry.

Chip

Some things were said. They weren't all entirely true. And I can see you look angry.

Jay

Chip. I don't want to hear it from you.

Chip

Yeah, well, you're gonna. Just, please relax before you do anything, okay? Please.

Condi

Jay would probably basically tug her arm away and start walking towards the captain's quarters.

Chip

Lot of respect for our fellow captains, huh?

Gillion

Oh, hey Jay.

Condi

Still walking.

Gillion

Saw you there. So just to piggyback off what Chip was saying. I understand, but it's not what you expect. Just be ready for that. I know you. And I know you're smart enough to want the truth.

Charlie

I don't try and stop her or anything.

Bizly

I'll get up next to the door once she gets in.

Charlie

(Laughs) Bruh.

Bizly

Well, I'm just making sure that nobody dies.

Grizzly

The door is locked if you try it, Jay.

Condi

Yeah, you know, I'll produce my thieves kit. Fuck it.

Bizly

I come up next to her while she's doing this.

Chip

One, you're not even doing that right. Two, you can just come back later.

Jay

No, Chip. I need to know now.

Chip

I... What is it with both of you guys and just being assholes?

Gillion

Hang on.

Charlie

I knock on the door a couple of times.

Grizzly

There's no direct response when you knock on the door at first, and then after the second or knock or so it's very quiet. It's just,

Lizzie

Not now. I'm not the fucking captain right now. I will be with you later.

Grizzly

Doesn't seem like she even knows who's at the door at the moment.

Charlie

Yeah, I figured. I just don't want to speak over Jay on this.

Condi

Jay's going to try to kick down the door.

Grizzly

(Laughs) Roll your strength check.

Gillion

[Jokingly] First of all, you're not even doing that right.

(Laughing)

Condi

[Die rolls] Twelve.

Grizzly

Your first kick doesn't go through it, but it does damage it. And it would startle. Yeah, so you do that.

Condi

She would hear yelling through the door as well.

Jay

Not now? Are you fucking serious right now, Lizzie?

Condi

And she's going to try to kick it again. [Die rolls] Natural fucking one. I break my ankle.

Chip

Jay, just calm down!

Jay

Chip. This is about my sister. I don't understand how you think I could be overreacting at all right now.

Chip

Because you don't know the whole story.

Jay

Okay? And all I want to know is the whole story.

Gillion

Trust her, Chip. [Towards Jay] Aim for the hinges.

Charlie

I give Jay guidance. (Laughing)

Condi

I aim for the hinges.

Charlie

I give Jay guidance.

Grizzly

You can roll the d4. Just can't roll again.

Condi

[Die rolls] I rolled a four, so I guess it's just a five now. Cool.

Grizzly

You kick on the door and you shout these things out at her. And there's a shuffle inside and the door before you get the next kick in. Even though it doesn't break open, the door swings open and in front of you you see her face is scrunched and there's eyeliner, black streaks that run down her face at the moment. And she looks at you through your eyes, Jay, as you look back with the same frustration and anger. And she says,

Lizzie

What the fuck do you want me to say to you right now? Kay, you want me to tell you that your sister fucking died and I saw it? Do you want to just automatically have someone to hate so fucking much and someone to blame? It's not that fucking simple, Jay. It's not easy for me either. So what the fuck do you get out of doing this?

Jay

Lizzie. This entire time you've known what happened to my sister, be it that you killed her or somebody else, and I don't fucking care. We've known each other for a while. Yeah, fuck you. We were becoming friends and you didn't think it was necessary even once, even just one time, to mention-

Lizzie

You just wanted me to fucking weasel it into the conversation over drinks, like, "Yeah, I saw your sister fucking die. And you know what? I also fucking loved her!" And every day, every time I see your fucking face, Jay, I have to see hers and I have to feel the guilt. How do you expect me to say something like that? Or even be ready to say it to you ever.

[Bizly and Charlie (hands up) scoot out of frame]

Condi

(Laughing) They're both gone.

Lizzie

You weren't fucking there.

Jay

I wasn't there. No. God knows I wish I was, Lizzie. Because all I've ever fucking wanted was to find whoever did it to my sister and bring them to justice.

Grizzly

After you say that, there's a moment of just pure silence where you don't break eye contact at all. And the other two boys just sort of back up a bit. And this is all happening within the doorway of the captain's quarters. And it feels like the whole world stops and is centered on this moment. Even the sea feels more still and the crew is quieter.

Jay

So, Lucy, who did it? You can have your history with my sister. You can look at me and feel pain. Maybe you deserve that. All I care about right now is knowing who did it.

Lizzie

Fuck me. (Laughs to herself) R.A.F.T. Soldiers. It was the fucking battle between R.A.F.T. And Shadowbeard's crew. She got the upper hand. They took advantage. She died in the crossfire. I don't fucking know the admiral or whoever the fuck she was under. And I don't know that person that was there. I don't know their name. I don't know if they're part of your family. I don't know if it was someone who no longer is with R.A.F.T., but I fucking blame them. That's the whole fucking reason I'm going to tear them down. I'm going to go to war and wipe them off this planet.

Condi

There's probably, like, a little bit of confusion that washes over Jay's face eventually. I think after probably just a moment's pause, it would probably just return to anger.

Jay

How the fuck am I supposed to believe that? Huh? Almost every single higher up in R.A.F.T. is a Ferin. Why would they- Why would they have my sister shot? In what world is that even possible to you?

Lizzie

Don't you think it's a bit too fucking much of a coincidence that with her death, every single pirate in the world, no matter who they are or what they've done, is automatically an outlaw? Don't you think it's too fucking close?

Jay

What, like she was some kind of martyr, for R.A.F.T.?

Lizzie

I don't know why you expect me to have all the answers. Pick a side and fucking stick with it. That's what I've done. You can hate me or play me or whatever. You could- I don't fucking care. I don't care if you want the full story or not, but I can't fucking bring her back. I can't change what happened. Fuck do you want from me? You want to keep taking your anger out on me? Because I- I promise you, I can take it. Or are we done here?

Jay

We're done here.

Grizzly

She slams the door.

Charlie

Turn to chip.

Bizly

I look at Gillion.

Chip

Nobody died.

Gillion

Could have gone worse?

Drey

Has anyone seen my pin?

Grizzly

And that's where we end the session.

Condi

Oh, my God.

Bizly

Old habits die hard.

Charlie

Oh Jesus. Half my notes are just all caps, "I got the pin" underlined, underlined, underlined.

(Laughing)

Bizly
