INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Before the lesson:** For each student, pass out 1.) watercolor paper 2.) newsprint 3.) black oil pastel 4.) paintbrush 5.) paper towel sheet. Prepare paint plates and water cups. For each student, prepare one plate with red, blue, and yellow paint. (Pass out after students are done drawing.)
2. **Review slides:** Go over slides with class to learn about colors, Paul Cezanne, and art lesson.
 - a. For directed drawing- I would recommend switching away from slides and demonstrating drawing steps using document projector. (A copy of the slides is included to guide you in drawing).
 - b. To prevent early spills, pass out water cups and paint as students are finishing up with drawing portion.
3. When students are done, remind them to write their name on the back of their art!
