COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Welcome to Word Play Cafe, where we will dive into the exciting world of reading at a beginner level! We will work our way through the five pillars of reading: phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension with a spiraling approach. Along the way, we will explore the magic within the pages of storybooks, indulge in themed treats, and engage with classmates in playful interactions that build relationships alongside reading skills!



COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1. Develop reading skills through a spiraling approach to learning.
- 2. Explore the five pillars of reading: phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.
- Advance individually as readers at different levels through group activities
 that reinforce the two main indicators of strong reading, alphabet
 recognition and phonemic awareness, and apply them at differing levels.
- 4. Advance skills through the use of take-home charts and worksheets.
- 5. Spark a love for reading through exposure to its limitlessness.
- 6. Create an atmosphere for success and accomplishment to foster a love for learning at differing paces.
- 7. Build relationships through a time of story-themed snacks.
- 8. Point to the Word of God as the pinnacle of reading endeavors.
- 9. Memorize the class verse: "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." Psalm 119:105
