FY27 Budget – Matt and John were present to go over the figures and the tax impacts for both Plainfield and Marshfield. Looking at an expenditure budget increase of 4.2% from FY26. Board discussions on the Homestead tax rate for each town. The board looked at what the figures would be with large cuts.

John and Matt shared a presentation on a full budget overview. Went over assessments, drivers of the budget, revenue sources.
