How to Start a Model UN Club at Your School

Step 1: Find a Faculty Sponsor

- Every Model UN team must have a faculty sponsor. This is usually a teacher or staff member willing to serve as the adult leader.
- The sponsor handles registration, communication with host schools, and chaperoning at conferences.

Step 2: Get School Approval

- Check with your activities or student life office about starting a new club.
- Follow your school's procedures for registering the club officially.

Step 3: Connect with Colorado MUN

- Have your sponsor contact Lucas Carmichael at lcarmichael@kentdenver.org.
- Your sponsor will be added to the Colorado MUN sponsors' email list to receive invitations and updates.

Step 4: Recruit Team Members

- Spread the word to classmates! Most schools have anywhere from 6 to 20 students on their team.
- Beginners are welcome — no experience is required to join.

Step 5: Attend Conferences

- Teams can attend monthly Saturday conferences hosted by schools across the state.
- The September training conferences are especially beginner-friendly.
- Conferences generally run 8:30–3:30. Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

Model UN is open to all students, and every team starts with just a few interested people. Find a teacher who's excited to support you, and you'll be on your way to joining our statewide community of schools!
