Topic 2: Bug Squashing Week

Welcome to Bug Squashing Week!

We have several test servers up and running with proposed fixes and features applied and ready to test. Here is the testing spreadsheet that shows the test server URLs. Please note that there are multiple tabs - the "General" tab has some handy links and test user account info.

Some of the ways you can participate in Bug Squashing Week:

- Log into the test servers to see if you find any bugs that have not been reported in <u>Launchpad</u> yet.
- Look at the list of proposed bug fixes and features that have been applied to the test servers read through the Launchpad ticket to understand the bug and then test out the proposed change. Add comments to the Launchpad ticket or, if the fix works great, you can sign off on it.
- Go through the <u>list of tickets that have the "New" status</u> if you can confirm one of them, change the status to Confirmed.
- Add "heat" to bug tickets by clicking the "Does this bug affect you?" link just under the bug title. This helps developers to prioritize work.
- If you see a ticket that does not have any tags yet, add tags from the <u>authorized tag list</u>.
- Provide additional feedback on existing bugs by adding comments to Launchpad tickets.

Bugs reviewed: all Cataloging bugs in the tracking sheet not signed off already

- 2111948: Enhanced MARC Editor: Adding Subfield Puts Focus on Wrong Box -SIGNED OFF!
- <u>1843837</u>: vandelay: record not appear selected after a merge target is selected batch import/export MARC - seems to work so far; Carol will test further and sign off
 - Carol's further testing showed it worked for Bib record loads but couldn't view Auth/Acq matches - Carol added a comment
- 1927538: Marc Batch Import/Export Queue Record matches missing Save Grid Settings Edit - Save Grid Settings option there but doesn't save changes
 - Carol added a comment
- <u>1735857</u>: Consider embedding Accessibility Metadata Project terms in public catalog Edit features appear in OPAC when fields fields 341 and 532 are present, otherwise empty; only "Content access mode" filters work in Advanced Search
 - o Carol tested further and added a comment.

- <u>1843837</u>: Record Bucket Export Items 852 Enhancements still needs test plan, not tested
 - Carol added a comment
