WHAT THIS IS

This petition seeks to place the Nevada Anti-Propaganda Protection Act (NAPPA) on the 2026 general election ballot.

If passed by the voters, this law will:

- San state-sponsored propaganda and psychological operations targeting Nevada residents
- Prohibit Al-generated manipulation in government and political messaging
- Outlaw election-year psychological influence campaigns, deceptive ads, and federal narrative operations within Nevada
- In Require all PACs, SuperPACs, and major donors to disclose their top 3 funders and total ad spend
- Mandate labeling of any Al-generated or federally influenced election content
- Impose penalties up to \$250,000 per violation and temporary bans from Nevada elections
- • M. Create a Nevada Anti-Propaganda Oversight Board to enforce, audit, and protect the public
- Take effect January 1, 2026

Nevada Anti-Propaganda Protection Act (NAPPA)

This initiative prohibits Nevada government agencies, employees, contractors, and public entities from creating, funding, or distributing propaganda, psychological operations, or narrative manipulation targeting residents of Nevada. It bans the use of Al-generated content, behavior modification tactics, or federally coordinated influence campaigns unless explicitly disclosed.

The measure further restricts political action committees (PACs), donors, and other entities from using misleading or Al-altered content in election advertisements. All paid election communications must disclose top funders, origin, and whether the message was federally influenced or Al-generated.

Violations by individuals or entities may result in civil penalties, removal from public office, public disclosure, and temporary or permanent bans from participating in Nevada elections.

The initiative establishes transparency requirements for all public media contracts and creates a five-member citizen-led oversight board to enforce compliance and investigate public complaints. Whistleblowers who expose violations may receive financial compensation and legal protection.
